

Transmission Main Maintenance Work

Location: CRW Right-of-Way near the Intersection of Route 225 and

Elizabeth Avenue

Possible Impacts: Construction Activity; Traffic Disruptions

Approximate Start Date: Late September

Working Hours: 7 a.m. to 5p.m. (may vary depending on project needs)

Capital Region Water's contractors will be performing necessary work in your area to maintain a drinking water transmission line near the intersection of Route 225 and Elizabeth Avenue. Work will take place along a CRW easement right-of-way.

The right-of-way ensures access to CRW's Primary Transmission Main pipe, which conveys water from the DeHart Reservoir to the CRW drinking water system, which serves the City of Harrisburg and parts of its neighboring communities.

Active maintenance work will occur between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Weather and other variables could require changes to the schedule, including working hours. Work is expected to be ongoing over multiple days.

Residents should expect to see and hear work activity in the right-of-way during active work hours. Minor traffic disruptions may be necessary as contractors work to load and unload equipment. Contractors will access the right-of-way via the gravel path off Elizabeth Avenue, across from Middle Paxton Elementary School.

Your drinking water service will not be impacted by this work.

A project representative will be onsite during working hours. No one will request to enter your home.
