

FIBER INTERNET

(LV Tech)

The fiber internet I am suggesting would be \$699 per month for the bandwidth and an additional \$20 for IP's. The total cost per month would be \$719.00. This is for 200M up and down speed.

I also recommend we keep the current Comcast, but I would work to lower the speed and price and use it as backup only, so that it would provide redundancy for all 3 entities as well. I can probably get the current bill under \$100 but it is dependent on the promotions available at the time.

- Current Comcast cable internet has multiple problems many times per week causing disruption to administration and police.
- The speed increase provides for additional bandwidth over the current upload speeds to accommodate the additional needs of cloud-based services that continue to escalate in usage. This is good for 3 years.
- DIA Fiber or "Dedicated Internet Access" Fiber. This means you are dedicated and guaranteed this bandwidth and uptime. After a specified amount of downtime (outlined in the contract), you receive credits on future invoices. This is a different kind of access from your standard Cable and even the shared fiber internet out there (such as Verizon FIOS, Comcast Cable, etc.)
