NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Proposals will be received by Crafton Borough via <u>PennBid</u> until 10:30 a.m. prevailing time on June 3, 2025, for the following project:

BROADHEAD STORM SEWER SEPARATION

Base Bid - Crafton Boulevard; Broadhead Avenue; Warren Street; Parke Street; Coulter Street; Belvidere Street; Crennel Avenue; N. Emily Street and N. Linwood Avenue

The project includes, but is not limited to, the installation of new storm sewer pipe, inlets and manholes; clearing and grubbing; traffic control; resident notification; erosion and sedimentation control measures; existing utility protection; reconstruction of streets, including, but not limited to, the removal of existing brick, concrete and bituminous paving and subbase and replacement with aggregate subbase and bituminous pavement; removal and replacement of existing concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk and handicap ramps; bituminous milling and overlay; and miscellaneous site restoration, complete in place.

Additional Bids – Multiple Streets

The project includes, but is not limited to, traffic control; resident notification; erosion and sedimentation control measures; existing utility protection; full depth street reconstruction; existing concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk and handicap ramp replacement; bituminous milling and overlay; and miscellaneous site restoration on multiple streets in Crafton Borough, complete in place.

All Proposals **must** be submitted electronically via PennBid (<u>www.PennBid.net</u>), before 10:30 a.m. prevailing time, on June 3, 2025. At that time, Bids will be opened with results publicly displayed on PennBid. **No** hard copy Bids will be accepted.

Copies of Drawings, Specifications, Instructions to Bidders, General Conditions, Forms of Proposals and Agreement and all other information relating to this Solicitation will be available at no cost on the PennBid site (www.PennBid.net).

Davis-Bacon Wage rates are required to be paid on this Project.

There will be a <u>Mandatory</u> Pre-Bid Meeting on May 21, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. prevailing time at 100 Stotz Avenue, Pittsburgh, PA 15205. Contractors who intend to bid <u>MUST</u> attend for their bids to be considered as **responsive**. "Attendance" for the purposes of this Paragraph shall mean being **present** for the entirety of the Meeting. Signing the Register at the beginning of the Meeting and leaving immediately thereafter will <u>not</u> constitute attendance.

Bidders must be **PennDOT pre-qualified** under the name of the <u>bidding entity</u> for the majority of the following Work Class Codes: A; C; C1; E; F; F1; F2; F3; G; H; H2; J; K; M; M2; M3; O and Q. Evidence of compliance <u>must</u> be submitted with the Bid for the Bid to be considered as **responsive**. Subcontractors shall also be required to be PennDOT pre-qualified for work categories not held by the successful Bidder or have verifiable experience.

Proposals must be accompanied by a Certified Check or Bidder's Bond from a Surety Company authorized to do business in Pennsylvania, made to the order of Crafton Borough in an amount equal to ten (10%) percent of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that, if the Proposal is accepted, the successful Bidder will enter into an Agreement within fifteen (15) days after Notice of the Award of the Contract.

The Proposals must be made to Crafton Borough, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, and shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days. No Bidder may withdraw his Proposal during the sixty (60) day period without forfeiting his Bid guarantee.

The Borough retains the right to award Contracts to the lowest **responsive**, PennDOT pre-qualified, and responsible Bidder based on consideration of quality of previous work, record of completing projects on time, history of payments to subcontractors and suppliers, maintenance of a permanent place of business, adequacy of equipment and plant to do the work, technical experience, a solid financial base to guarantee contract completion and all other factors deemed relative by the Borough.

Bidders are advised that the Borough expressly reserves the right to reject all bids, and specifically reserves the right to award to the lowest responsive, PennDOT pre-qualified, and responsible Bidder a contract for all or any portions of the work listed in the Proposal, and in awarding a contract for less than the total work listed, or less than all portions of the work listed, the awarded contract price will be determined from the total quantities for each time listed and the unit price bid for each item listed.

Bidders are also advised that the Base Bid and **all** Additional Bids must be completed on the Proposal Form for the bid to be considered as **responsive** and that the Borough intends to award the Contract to the lowest PennDOT pre-qualified, responsible, and **responsive** Bidder based on the total bid submitted for the Base Bid and/or the total bid submitted for <u>any</u> combination of the Base Bid and Additional Bids as selected at the Borough's sole discretion.

Performance, Maintenance, and Labor and Material Payment Bonds, along with Public Liability and Property Damage Certificates of Insurance in the amounts specified, as well as Certificates of Workman's Compensation must be filed with the executed Agreement upon acceptance of the Proposal from the successful Bidder.

Crafton Borough also reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, or any part thereof, for any reason, and reserves the right to waive any informality therein.
