**Inspection Planned for Ramp to NB I-83 in the City of Harrisburg,
Dauphin County**

Shoulder restriction on the ramp

Harrisburg, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced today that an inspection is planned for this Friday, November 22, on the ramp bridge to northbound Interstate 83 from Front Street in the City of Harrisburg, Dauphin County.

Weather permitting, this work will be performed from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM Friday, November 22. There will be a shoulder restriction on the ramp.

Travelers are reminded to be alert for these operations, to obey work zone signs, and to use caution when driving through work zones for their safety, as well as for the safety of the road crews.
