What is the W3C?

The Waccasassa Water and Wastewater Cooperative is a wholesale regional water and wastewater utility located within Levy County. The W3C, formed as a special district, and includes Town of Otter Creek, Cedar Key Water and Sewer District, and Town of Bronson as its members who are responsible to implement, operate, and maintain critical regional infrastructure that consist of both a water treatment plant and wastewater treatment plant, as well as approximately 35 miles of water pipeline and 35 miles of wastewater collection system.
