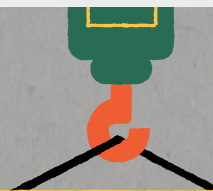

New Trash Contract

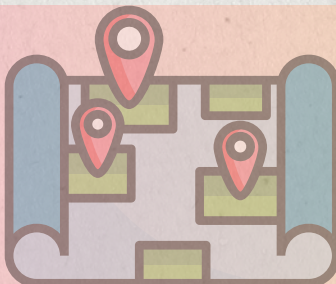
On July 1, 2025, Dover Township will begin a new contract with the lowest bidder, Penn Waste for refuse and recycling collection.
