**Inspection Planned on Route 443 Bridge Over Route 22/322 in
Dauphin County**

Lane restrictions will be in place on Route 22/322

Harrisburg, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced today that an inspection is scheduled for tomorrow and Thursday on the Route 443 (Fishing Creek Valley Road) bridge spanning Route 22/322 in Middle Paxton Township, Dauphin County

Weather permitting, the bridge will be inspected from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM Wednesday, September 18, and Thursday, September 19. There will be alternating left and right lane closures in both directions of Route 22/322 during work hours.

Travelers are reminded to be alert for these operations, to obey work zone signs, and to use caution when driving through work zones for their safety, as well as for the safety of the road crews.
