Dear Customer,

I am writing to you to provide details regarding Aqua Pennsylvania's upcoming construction work that is scheduled in your neighborhood or place of business.

Aqua Pennsylvania will begin the replacement of 4,968 feet of aging 10-inch cast iron pipe with new 10-inch ductile iron water main on Meadowbrook Avenue, including Drummers Way, North Penn Street, Summit Avenue and Oakdale Avenue. Work will begin starting on June 19th, 2025 anticipated to be completed on or around October 31st, 2025.

The \$2,031,862.45 project is part of our continuing infrastructure improvement program that replaced more than 25 miles of aging main in Montgomery County in 2025 to improve service reliability for customers. The new water main will reduce the potential for main breaks and discolored water and improve water flow in the area.

Construction will generally take place weekdays between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. During times of construction access will be provided for emergency, mail, and trash service. Residents will have access to their properties, but at times will need to enter from different directions due to changing work zones. Following installation, the new main will be flushed, chlorinated, and tested for water quality before being placed into service. During the chlorination/testing phase, activity on the job site will be limited. Once the water quality testing has been completed, we will transfer each water service and fire hydrant to the new main. When all final connections are made to mains on side streets, the old main will abandoned. It is important to note the trench will be covered with *temporary* blacktop at the end of each workday. Once all of the activity described has been completed, permanent restoration will follow in about 30 to 60 days.

We will notify customers ahead of any planned water service interruptions and will provide 48 hours advance notice for any scheduled interruption greater than 30 minutes.

Apart from the specific project details described here, you may refer to the accompanying door hanger for more information on what to expect as we begin our construction project in your neighborhood.
