## DECLARATION OF DISASTER / SNOW EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026, a severe winter weather with potential for snow, sleet and freezing rain threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of Hellam Township, York County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the storm may endanger the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Hellam Township and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Hellam Township may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Hellam Township:

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors of Hellam Township, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, do hereby proclaim the existence of a disaster emergency in Hellam Township;

FURTHER, we direct the Hellam Township Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, we authorize officials of Hellam Township to act as necessary to meet the current demands of this emergency, namely: closing streets and roads to public traffic, by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.

This Proclamation shall take effect at 6:00 p.m., Saturday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026 and remain in effect until 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
