

Chapter 51. Fireworks

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Swoyersville 12-16-1972 by Ord. No. 21-1972. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 51-1. Prohibited acts.

From and after the passage of this chapter, it shall be unlawful to store, sell, keep for sale or discharge any kind of fireworks, firecracker, torpedo, cap, gun, pistol, revolver, cane, cannon or other substance, thing or appliance designed or intended for noisemaking or for pyrotechnic display within the limits of the Borough of Swoyersville, except under the conditions provided for in § 51-2 hereof.

§ 51-2. Issuance of permits for public displays.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to issue permits for public exhibitions of fireworks under the direct supervision of experts in the handling of the same.

§ 51-3. Violations and penalties.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine or penalty of not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 and the costs of prosecution, or imprisonment in the Luzerne County Prison for a period not exceeding 30 days.
