The plan will identify specific projects and routes—such as sidewalks, multi-use paths, bike lanes, and bike routes—that can be improved or developed to provide safer, more convenient options for active travel to everyday destinations, including homes, workplaces, schools, medical facilities, shops, restaurants, bus stops, and parks.

Help us shape Plan goals and let us know what your priority is for our four primary focus areas for action:

1. A quick-implementation built environment project that the Borough has control over and can put into effect right away.
2. A program or campaign to raise awareness of active transportation and generate enthusiasm locally.
3. A specific policy recommendation to support plan implementation and mode shift.
4. A primary infrastructure construction project to seek design funding for right away.
