**A RESOLUTION OF WARRINGTON TOWNSHIP REQUIRING THE
MONTHLY SUBMISSION AND PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF
WELLSVILLE FIRE COMPANY MEETING MINUTES AND FINANCIAL
REPORTS**

WHEREAS, Warrington Township (“Township”) has entered into a Fire Service Agreement with the Wellsville Fire Company (“Fire Department”) for the provision of fire protection and rescue services; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the Fire Service Agreement requires that the Fire Department provide all monthly meeting minutes and Treasurer’s reports for both Trustee and Membership meetings to the Township on a monthly basis and in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to ensure transparency, accountability, and accessibility of information related to Township-funded operations by ensuring that such materials are accessible to the Board and the public in a consistent transparent manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Warrington Township, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- 1. Availability at Public Meetings.** All submitted meeting minutes and Treasurer’s reports submitted by the Wellsville Fire Company shall be made available to the Board of Supervisors and the public at regularly scheduled public meetings of the Board.
- 2. Administration.** The Township staff are authorized to include such materials in meeting packets or otherwise make them available at the meeting for members of the public.
- 3. Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution, which shall remain in full force and effect.

4. Effective Date

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
