



Boil Water Notice Rescinded

09/23/2026

On September 22, 2026, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required **The City of Krum** public water system, **TX0610007**, to issue a **Boil Water Notice** to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water **no longer requires boiling** prior to use as of **September 23, 2026**.

THE GENERAL AREA(s) THAT WAS AFFECTED: All water customers on South Second Street, Jones, South First, Jackson, Britton and Businesses on South side of F.M. 1173 between Jackson and F.M. 156.
