The City of Cedar Key, Florida hereby requests qualifications from individuals or firms to provide engineering services for an FWC Florida Boating Improvement Program Grant project.

The project involves providing the engineering design, biddable engineering plans and specifications as well as developing and submitting applications to the governing permitting agencies for the Boat Launch Project at the Cedar Key City Marina.
