TENASKA GENERATING STATION: Under-Permitted Polluter

WHAT'S THE ISSUE?

In 2020, Tenaska Generating Station was named as one of Pennsylvania's "dirty dozen," ranking as one of the top 12 polluters in the state, emitting over 2.6 million tons of greenhouse gas emissions.

This gas-fired power plant is located in Westmoreland County, just behind the Pittsburgh Renaissance Festival. It has been **operating without a Title V permit for air pollution** since at least 2018. Instead, the facility has been operating under a patchwork of temporary permits that fails to evaluate the air and water pollution of the facility as a whole.

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW?

Tenaska is applying for its Title V permit. **We need your help** to encourage DEP to add more protective measures!
