In conjunction with the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection, Veolia has issued a boil water advisory affecting certain customers in Newberry, PA. The following order has been issued.

Drinking Water Warning

BOIL YOUR WATER BEFORE

Some Veolia Water Newberry Customers May Be At Increased Risk From Microbial Contamination.

During a routine tank inspection an opening was discovered on top of the Grandview Water Storage tank. This opening allowed foreign matter to enter the storage tank.

What should I do?

DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST. Bring all water to a rolling boil, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using; or use bottled water. You should use boiled or bottled water for drinking, making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth, and food preparation until further notice. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.

Inadequately treated water may contain disease-causing organisms. These organisms include bacteria, viruses, and parasites, which can cause symptoms such as nausea, cramps, diarrhea, and associated headaches.

These symptoms, however, are not caused only by organisms in drinking water, but also by other factors. If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, you may want to seek medical advice. Guardians of infants and young children and people at increased risk, such as pregnant women, some of the elderly and people with severely compromised immune systems, should seek advice from their health care providers.

What happened? What is being done?

The tank has been isolated from service in the water system. Efforts are underway to remove this material, make repairs, and sterilize the tank before returning it to service.

We will inform you when all corrective actions have been completed and when you no longer need to boil your water.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
