The Myrtle Street Natural Gas
Infrastructure Replacement
Project is part of a
comprehensive replacement plan
to upgrade the gas pipelines in
Littlestown Borough

Project plans consists of:

- Approximately 3,700 linear feet of mainline pipe will be replaced
- Approximately 85 customers will have service lines upgraded
- Approximately 64 customers will have their meters relocated to the outside
- Pipeline replacement work will take place on the following streets:
 Myrtle Street, Playground Place, Park Avenue, West Crouse Park, North Crouse Park, East Crouse Park, Parkway Drive, and East Locust Street
- Hours of operation will be 7:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, with some Saturday work possible, and holidays are excluded
- Lane closures and detours will be in effect only during work hours
- Project is tentatively proposed to begin in January 2025 and is estimated to take approximately six months to complete
 - Project duration may be impacted by weather and/or unforeseen construction impediments in existing ground conditions
- Customer properties will be restored to pre-project conditions following the completion of main and service line work. Road, sidewalk, and other right-of –way restoration will be completed using reasonable local municipal standards or PennDOT's standards of restoration
- Work will be performed by Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania contractor Kinsley Construction






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Project Map
