Finance Committee

Motion to approve the bond payment, due June 1, 2026, in the amount of \$246,923.36.

Motion to accept the resignation of Avalon Borough, Ward 3, Councilmember Justin Harkleroad.

Motion to advertise and accept applications for the open Council seat in Ward 3.

Public Safety Committee

Motion to approve Resolution #25-1368, a resolution proclaiming May 11 through May 16, 2026, National Police Week, encouraging residents to honor the service of law enforcement officers serving in communities across the United States.

Motion to approve Resolution #26-1365, a resolution accepting the Allegheny County Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Motion to approve the purchase 10 Motorola V700 Body Cameras from Motorola Solutions, to include a 5 year warranty and cloud storage migration in the amount of \$26,676.00.

/Note: This purchase will be paid over 5 years, beginning June 2026, with an annual payment of \$5,335.20, includes a Camera Refresh in year 3 (current body cameras will be replaced with new cameras available at that time). This also eliminates the need for a physical server and annual licensing fees.
