

Resolution No. 2026 - 12

Approving 4th of July 2026 Fireworks Hold Harmless Agreement

WHEREAS, each year the City of Latrobe 4th of July Celebration, Inc. a Pennsylvania Non-Profit Corporation, holds a fireworks display celebrating the 4th of July; and

WHEREAS, Lehigh Specialty Melting, Inc. permits the use of its land to conduct the fireworks display; and,

WHEREAS, each year Lehigh Specialty Melting, Inc. requests certain entities to indemnify and hold harmless for any liability or damage resulting from the fireworks display; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Latrobe has been requested to execute a Hold Harmless Agreement for the Latrobe 4th of July Fireworks Display, attached as Exhibit A; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to authorize the Mayor and/or Manager to sign the agreement described above and provide the certificate of insurance referenced in the agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Latrobe, in a regular public meeting assembled and by authority of the same:

Section 1. That the Council and the City of Latrobe authorize the Mayor and /or Manager to sign the Hold Harmless Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A, on behalf of the City for the July 4th 2026 fireworks display, proposed by Lehigh Specialty Melting, Inc., in form attached hereto.

Hold Harmless Agreement for The Latrobe 4th of July Fireworks Display


Lehigh Specialty Melting Inc. ("LSM") has agreed to provide a site on LSM's property for the firing of a fireworks display to be held on July 4, 2026 for The Latrobe 4th of July Fireworks Display. This agreement is being executed to provide Greater Latrobe 4th of July Celebration Inc. with a site for the Fireworks display for Latrobe 4th of July Celebration.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Greater Latrobe 4th of July Celebration Inc. and Acme Fireworks Company Inc. (collectively, the "Indemnifying Parties") do hereby jointly and severally agree and covenant with LSM to defend, indemnify and hold LSM, its shareholders, directors, officers, employees and affiliates (collectively, the "LSM Parties") harmless from any and all claims, demands, suits or damages, losses and/or expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) for personal injury (including but not limited to bodily injury and death) and/or property damage which may be asserted by or against any one or more of the LSM Parties arising from or in any way related to the Indemnifying Parties' fireworks display at the LSM property on the Event Date. As a condition to accessing the LSM property, LSM must receive from each of the Indemnifying Parties a certificate of insurance, together with a copy of the additional insured endorsement, evidencing general liability insurance and automobile liability insurance coverages with limits of liability of not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 in aggregate, as well as statutory workers' compensation, and such certificates shall name each of the LSM Parties as an additional insured. The limits of insurance specified in this agreement shall in no way constitute the upper limits of liability for which the Indemnifying Parties are responsible under this agreement. The rain date for the fireworks display will be July 5, 2026 depending on weather.


