Finance Committee

Motion to approve Resolution #26-1359, a resolution for Avalon Borough to be included in the Allegheny County Community Block Grant and Home Investment Partnership Program for three (3) program Years – 2027, 2028 and 2029,

Public Safety Committee

Motion to approve Resolution #26-1360, a resolution establishing an official policy for enforcement of non-criminal federal immigration laws.

Department of Public Works and Engineering & Infrastructure

Motion to approve the Lennon Smith Souleret Engineering Service Order Authorization for the layout, bidding and construction phase services relative to the N. Birmingham Avenue Wall project in the amount of \$17,200.

Note: this project is being completed through a Local Share Account Grant in the amount of \$221,350.

Motion to approve Change Order #3 for the Elizabeth Avenue Road and Sidewalk Replacement project to remove and dispose of a tree and stump in the amount of \$4,500.

Note: The project is being completed via a Multi Modal grant. This tree is located at 338 Elizabeth Avenue and is impeding the replacement of the curb repairs designed for this project.

Motion to authorize the Borough Manager to apply and administer PENNDOT’s Green Light Go Grant for the South Home Avene and California Avenue Traffic Signal Improvement project.

Note: Avalon Borough has agreed to commit \$74,765.00 of local funding to the \$373,825 estimated project costs (20% grant match requirement).

Motion to approve Shultz Ford to repair the 2011 Ford F-550 dump truck #6 in the amount not to exceed \$10,000.

Note: The vehicle has a turbo engine. Check engine light is going on and vehicle is going into DE Rate and engine is roaring. Road test and numerous error codes verified and need to be addressed.

Motion to approve the purchase of a 2026 Ford F-550 Regular Cab Gasoline Chassis vehicle from Woltz & Wind Ford, with uplift package to include stainless steel dump body, Western Pro Plow, salt spreader and hydraulics from Sabre Equipment Inc, for an amount not to exceed \$150,000.

Note: The vehicle and uplift package quotations were received from COSTARS vendors.

Motion to approve Resolution 26-1361, a resolution proclaiming April 19 through April 25, 2026, National Library Week, encouraging residents to visit the Avalon Public Library.
