***STORMWATER/MS4 PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT***

As part of the Youngwood Borough Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System, or MS4 Permit with the Pennsylvania DEP, the Youngwood Borough Council would like to remind all people who live in and work within the Borough that our storm sewer inlets, curbs and gutters, drainage ditches and storm pipes discharge directly and untreated into Jacks Run, Sewickley Creek, and other natural waterway tributaries within the Borough. In order to help keep our streams and lakes clean and pollution-free, we remind residents and businesses to please:

Use correct snow melt and de-icing methods. These should not include any hazardous liquids. Avoid using anything that could be corrosive to concrete or asphalt surfaces.
