MAIN STREET PARKING RESTRICTIONS – ADDITIONAL NIGHT OF MILLING OPERATIONS

The Town of Louisa is advising residents, businesses, and visitors that unforeseen circumstances have delayed the construction process and require an additional night of milling operations on Main Street.

Milling operations will continue tonight, September 10, 2026, beginning at approximately 8:00 p.m. and continuing through approximately 8:00 a.m. on September 11, 2026. The affected area will be Main Street from 310 W. Main Street to Fredericksburg Avenue.

NO PARKING will be permitted within the designated work area during the scheduled overnight operations. Motorists and visitors are asked to remove all vehicles from the affected areas prior to the start of work to allow the contractor to safely and efficiently complete the milling operations.

The additional night of milling is necessary due to unforeseen circumstances that delayed the construction process during the initial scheduled work period.

A second round of parking restrictions will also be required during the paving phase of the project. The Town will provide additional notification regarding the paving schedule and associated parking restrictions once the contractor's schedule has been confirmed.

Please be advised that the contractor's schedule may be adjusted due to weather, unforeseen site conditions, or other operational considerations. This press release will be updated as the contractor's schedule is updated.

The Town appreciates the cooperation and patience of residents, businesses, and visitors while these necessary roadway improvements are completed.

For everyone's safety, please use caution when traveling through the work area and follow all posted traffic control and parking restrictions.
