



Grade Crossing Renewal & Closure Set For Main Street in North Wales Borough April 9-14

LOCATION: Main Street (North Wales Borough)

RAIL LINE: Lansdale/Doylestown Line

COUNTY: Montgomery

CONSTRUCTION DATES: Thursday, April 9, 2026, through Tuesday, April 14, 2026

SCOPE: SEPTA in-house forces will perform full-depth renewal of the Main Street grade crossing. Crews will be removing the existing crossing surface as well as worn ties and rails through the roadway. SEPTA will reconstruct the grade crossing with a new asphalt surface and install new ties and rails. The grade crossing and the approaches will be milled and paved before reopening the road to service. The new grade crossing will provide a smoother ride across the tracks and provide a new surface free of any cracks and potholes.

ROAD DETOUR DURING CONSTRUCTION:

Full Closure: Thursday, April 9, 2026, at 9:00 AM, through Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at 6:00 PM

To facilitate construction during this **round-the-clock closure**, **Main Street will be closed to all vehicle through traffic between East Montgomery Street and West Montgomery Street.**

Traffic detour will be posted and maintained for the duration of the project. Local access will be maintained up to the construction zone. **At no time will access to local businesses and private property, north or south of the crossing be barricaded/blocked off.**

Main Street will be closed at its intersection with the railroad tracks beginning Thursday, April 9, 2026, at 9:00 AM. Main Street motorists will be directed to use **U.S. 202 (Dekalb Pike), Route 63 (Welsh Road), North Wales Road and Walnut Street:**

- Westbound Main Street traffic will be detoured at the intersection of Sumneytown Pike and U.S. 202, onto U.S. 202 North; west on Route 63; south on North Wales Road; south on Walnut Street and ending at Main Street.

- Eastbound Main Street traffic will be detoured at the intersection of Main Street and Walnut Street, north on Walnut Street to North Wales Road; north on North Wales Road; east on Route 63; south on U.S. 202 and ending at Sumneytown Pike and U.S. 202.
- **All traffic lanes will open on or before 6:00 PM Tuesday, April 14, 2026.**

LANSDALE/DOYLESTOWN REGIONAL RAIL SERVICE:

Service on the Lansdale/Doylestown Line will operate as normal during this track maintenance project. However, on **Saturday, April 11, 2026**, and **Sunday, April 12, 2026**, opposite side boarding will be in place at several stations.

- **On April 11th**, passengers must board/exit all trains on the **outbound platforms** at Pennbrook Station, North Wales Station and Gwynedd Valley Station.
- **On April 12th**, passengers must board/exit all trains on the **inbound platforms** at Pennbrook Station, North Wales Station and Gwynedd Valley Station.



BUS ROUTE 96 DETOUR INFORMATION:

Bus Route 96 will be detoured for the duration of the project. Look for posted signs. See detour information below:

- Northbound – Via Main Street, Left - W. Prospect Avenue, Right - Center Street, Right - Walnut Street, regular route.
- Southbound – Via Walnut Street, Left - Center Street, Left - W. Prospect Avenue, Right - Main Street, regular route.

❖ Residents should be mindful of buses operating on these residential streets, observe posted signage, and use caution when crossing at intersections.
