Dear Property Owner,

The Patton Township Board of Supervisors has awarded the Valley Vista Drive Improvement Project, Contract 2026-C2, to Big Rock Paving. The project includes repaving Valley Vista Drive between North Atherton Street and Carnegie Drive. A Notice-to-Proceed was issued on June 15, 2026. Construction activities are expected to begin the week of June 28 and continue through July, weather permitting.

All construction will take place during **night-time hours (8:00 PM to 6:00 AM), Sunday through Friday**. Night work is being utilized to reduce impacts to daytime traffic, minimize disruptions to motorists, and improve safety for both workers and travelers.

**Work included in this project consists of:**

- Milling the existing roadway surface
- Base asphalt repairs (as needed)
- Placement of a bituminous scratch course and final wearing course
- Upgrading ADA curb ramps and adding approximately 905 feet of sidewalk (to be completed by the Patton Township Road Crew)
- Upgrading pedestrian push buttons at new ADA ramps
- Restoring pavement markings

At least one lane of traffic will be open at all times during construction. For commercial properties, **one driveway access point will remain open while businesses are operating**. Patton Township appreciates your patience and cooperation as we complete this important roadway improvement.
