

Lifting Boil Water Advisory

Boil Water Advisory to Consumers of The Town of Louisa LIFTED

As of March 12, 2026, the Boil Water Advisory has been lifted for those impacted by the service interruption that occurred Tuesday, March 10, 2026 along Ellisville Rd, Johnsons Pond Ln, and N. Side Park.

The Boil Water Advisory was issued on March 10, 2026 due to a water main break, which caused a loss of pressure in the areas described above.

A series of bacteriological samples were collected and sent to a state certified lab. All samples collected on March 10, 2026 and March 11, 2026 were absent of both total coliform and *E. coli* bacteria in the area where the Boil Water Advisory is currently being lifted.

Residents are encouraged to flush the water lines in their house and they may then safely resume normal use of their tap water.
