HEALTH COUNCIL FUNCTIONS - A health council shall prepare a community health plan, updated at regular intervals. Each community health plan shall include a county or tribal health assessment and inventory of health resources; identification of health priorities determined through independent, community-based planning processes; and strategies and resources to address health priorities. A health council shall also monitor health and health care programs and services in order to identify potential gaps and to reduce potential duplication; collaborate with other entities to develop programs, networks, partnerships and coalitions as necessary to improve health; advise the board in its jurisdiction and other entities regarding policies that affect health; facilitate communication among local jurisdictions, state agencies and other entities; and identify additional public and private resources to improve health in its respective jurisdiction.
