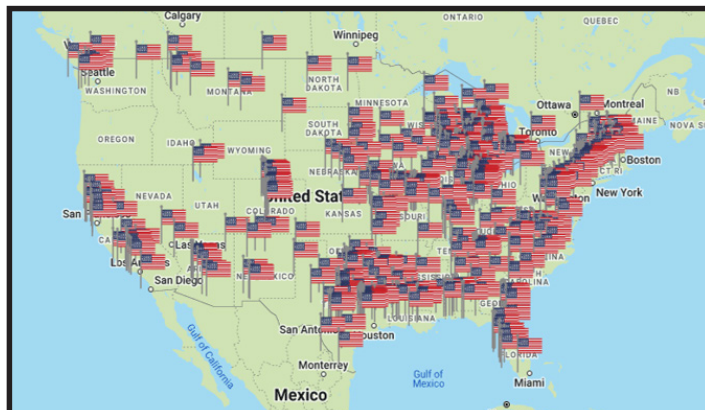


HOMELESS VETERAN PROGRAM

The Tunnel to Towers Homeless Veteran Program assists veterans and their families across the nation, no matter their location.

Our National Case Management Network currently provides housing assistance and access to necessary supportive services in nearly every state.

Our team has built a national network of over 1,000 public and private organizations, VA agents, attorneys, landlords, mental health counselors, financial counselors, and large-scale employers.

This rapidly growing network allows our team to be able to address each veteran's specific issues, to ensure they can sustain their new housing accommodations while working towards achieving their long-term objectives.

Our Program's goal is to help homeless veterans reintegrate into their community, as well as provide veterans who are at-risk of becoming homeless with the support they need to not backslide into homelessness.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & WAYS TO APPLY



The Tunnel to Towers Foundation's Veterans Villages offer long-term supportive housing and 24/7 comprehensive wraparound services to help veterans who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

Our Houston and Atlanta Veterans Villages are now open.

In 2026 we will be opening 5 locations:

- Memphis
- Charleston
- Denver
- Detroit
- Harrisburgh



To qualify for the Veterans Village supportive housing program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

Demographic Information

- The applicant must be over 18 years of age

Military Service

- The applicant must be a Veteran of the U.S. Military Service with an Honorable Discharge or discharges under conditions other than Dishonorable **AND**
- Veteran must have completed a minimum of 180 days of service

Documentation

- A government issued ID that includes name, date of birth, and photograph is required
- Proof of military service, such as a DD-214 or VA ID is required
- Income verification documents

Other

- Participant must be interested in a single-room occupancy housing program (one person per unit)
- Participant must be willing to undergo a background and credit check

Documentation

- A government issued ID that includes name, date of birth, and photograph is required

- Income verification documents
