## The New Dover Township Website Is Here

Dover Township is pleased to announce that our redesigned website is now live at: [www.DoverTownship.org](http://www.DoverTownship.org)

The new website was created to make Township information easier to find and Township services easier to use. Residents, property owners, businesses, visitors, and community partners can now explore a fresh, updated online experience designed around the way people actually look for information.

The redesigned site includes improved navigation for Government, Departments, Community, Business, Services, and Help Me... sections. These areas make it easier to locate public information, contact the correct department, apply for permits, pay utility bills, register for Parks & Recreation programs, review public notices, and access meeting materials.

One of the biggest new features is **Ask Dover**, a website assistance tool that helps users quickly find answers using information already available on the Township website. If an answer is not available, Township staff can use that feedback to follow up, improve website content, or provide additional explanation when needed.

The new website also expands public access to Township records through a more robust Township Archives section. Residents can browse folder-style access to agendas, minutes, budgets, audits, public documents, plans, maps, reports, and other important Township records.

Dover Township remains committed to improving communication, expanding public access to information, and making Township services easier to use. Thank you for your patience during the redesign process, and welcome to the new online home of Dover Township.



# Public Meetings

## Board of Supervisors

The Board of Supervisors will hold their regular meetings in the Dover TWP Community Bldg located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 6:00 PM on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Mondays of the month. The Dover Township Board of Supervisors invites the public to attend.

## Industrial & Commercial Development Committee

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 4:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

## Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipalities Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

## Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 6:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

## Zoning Hearing Board

The Dover Township Zoning Hearing Board is a five member Board. This body is a Quasi Judicial Body whose authority is granted by the Municipalities Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. There is one alternate member. The term is a five year staggered term. Local authority guidance for operational decisions is established by the Dover Township Zoning Ordinance and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month **AS NEEDED**. # Rainfall and “I & I”

Heavy rainfall can create what’s known as Inflow & Infiltration (I & I) - extra stormwater entering the sanitary sewer system through cracked pipes, leaking manholes, sump pumps and illegal connections.

Pipes can become overloaded, pump stations work harder, treatment costs increase and the risk of backups and overflows rises.

Here are a few simple ways homeowners can help reduce excess water entering the system:

- Check sump pump connections: sump pumps should be discharged outside, not into sanitary sewer lines.
- Inspect downspouts: Make sure gutters and downspouts direct water away from your foundation.
- Repair damaged sewer laterals: Cracked or aging private sewer lines can allow groundwater infiltration.
- Report suspicious water issue: Standing water near manholes or sinkholes may indicate infrastructure problems.

## Common areas where inflow and infiltration occur

### On Private Property:

1. Improper foundation or roof drain connections
2. Uncapped cleanout
3. Root intrusion
4. Breaks or open joints in service lateral

### In Public System:

1. Breaks or open joints in lateral or main pipes
2. Faulty manhole covers
3. Open joints or cracks in service chamber

# Grit Removal Tank Rehab Project

The Dover Township Wastewater Treatment Plant has successfully completed a rehabilitation project on the facility's Grit Removal Tank. The Grit Removal Tank plays an important role in the wastewater treatment process by removing heavy inorganic materials such as sand, gravel, coffee grounds, and eggshells from incoming wastewater. This early treatment step helps protect pumps and downstream equipment from abrasion, excessive wear, and clogging. It also prevents long-term grit accumulation in larger treatment tanks, which can reduce the plant's capacity to handle wastewater efficiently.

As part of the project, deteriorated ductile iron piping that had developed holes and was limiting effective grit removal was replaced with new stainless-steel piping. The upgraded piping is more resistant to corrosion and damage caused by prolonged exposure to raw sewage. With the rehabilitation complete, grit removal operations have resumed and will help extend the lifespan and reliability of downstream treatment equipment throughout the facility.

# Northern York County Regional Police



## EXPLORERS POST #1445



In 2019, the Northern York County Regional Police Department established the only active Explorer Post in York County. The Explorers program is designed for adolescents who are between the ages of 14 and 20 years of age. The program gives the Explorers basic instruction in various phases of law enforcement. Post members meet biweekly at the NYCRPD Range Building, and they continue to learn police policy and procedures through hands on application of the subject matter.

In June 2026, Explorers Post #1445 will hold their weeklong Explorers Academy that incorporates hands-on training with the York County Negotiations Response Team (NRT), and several scenarios that are conducted where the Explorers are given the opportunity to watch NRT negotiators practice and are able to take over various roles within the NRT scenarios.

Dover Township's Property Maintenance Code helps ensure that homes, businesses, and outdoor spaces are kept safe, sanitary, and well cared for. These standards are in place to protect public health and safety while also supporting the appearance and quality of our neighborhoods.

Property owners are responsible for maintaining their buildings and lots, including things like sanitation, exterior upkeep, and general safety. If a property owner does not address a violation after receiving notice, the Township may arrange for the work to be completed and charge the cost to the property owner. # Do I Need A Burn Permit??

The need for a burn permit depends on the type of fire and the zoning district in which the property is located. In general, fires are classified as either recreational fires or open burning, and different rules apply to each. You can determine your zoning district by searching your address on the Dover Township [interactive zoning map](#).

**Recreational Fires (No Burn Permit Required):** Recreational fires are permitted in all zoning districts within the Township and do not require a burn permit, provided all requirements are met. To be permitted as a recreational fire:

- Fires must be contained within an appliance designed for that purpose (such as a fire bowl, fire ring, chiminea, or stone fireplace). A burn barrel is not an approved appliance.
- The appliance must be located a safe distance from structures and property lines to reduce fire risk and minimize smoke impacts.
- Fires must be actively supervised at all times and extinguished if left unattended.
- Recreational fires larger than 2'x2' require prior approval from the Fire Marshal by contacting the township municipal office, a burn permit is not required.
- Only sticks and untreated, unfinished wood may be used as fuel.

**Open Burning (Burn Permit Required):**

Open burning is only permitted with a valid burn permit and is generally restricted to properties located within agricultural and conservation zoning districts.

In certain cases, properties zoned residential may qualify for an agricultural use exemption as defined by the Township Zoning Ordinance. In these instances, open burning may be allowed and burn permit is required unless the activity meets the definition of a recreational fire. All open burning must comply with the conditions outlined in the Township ordinance and on the burn permit application.

# Yard Waste Guidelines

For Dover Township Residents

**Yard Waste is...**  
material such as tree trimmings, shrubbery and other organic landscape vegetation not listed below.



**Do NOT place these items out for yard waste collection:**

### How to Prepare Yard Waste:

- Place your yard waste in biodegradable brown paper bags or bundle it with biodegradable twine in easy-to-handle bundles.
  - Bundles may be no longer than 5 feet in length.
  - Bundles may not weigh more than 30 pounds each.
  - Branches may not exceed 6 inches in diameter.
- Yard waste must then be placed at the curb on your scheduled yard waste pick up day before your collection time.
- An Unlimited number of bags or bundles may be placed at the curb.

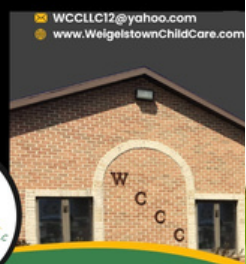

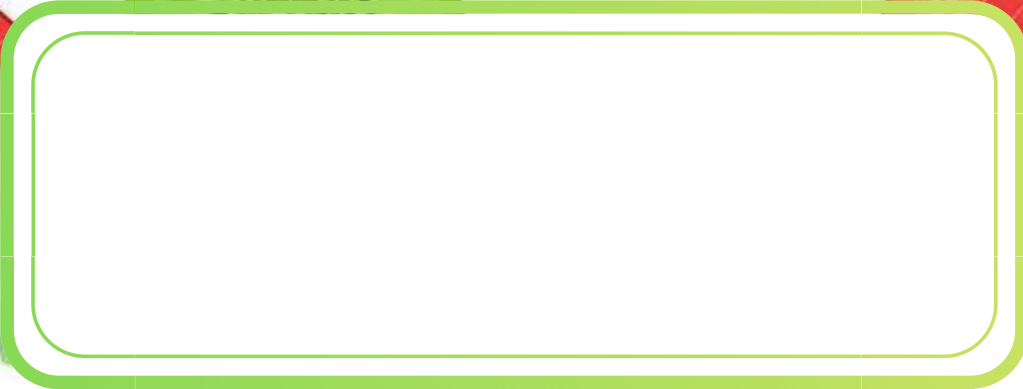
