
In conjunction with Governor Shapiro's Proclamation of Disaster Emergency dated January 23rd, 2026, I hereby extend it said declaration to the Borough of Ligonier.

A local state of emergency is in effect immediately with the boundaries of the Borough of Ligonier due to hazardous winter storm conditions. All municipal departments and emergency services are authorized to take necessary action to ensure public safety, including.

1. Snow removal and road clearing.
2. Deployment of emergency personnel and equipment.
3. Establishment of warning shelters and emergency facilities.
4. Coordination with county and state agency as needed.

Residents are urged to remain indoors and avoid unnecessary travel. To allow road crews and emergency personnel to operate safely, businesses and organizations are encouraged to close or operate remotely where possible to reduce travel hazards. The declaration shall remain in effect until conditions have improved and the emergency is formally terminated.
