Resurfacing Project to Begin on Pleasant View Road in Fairview Township, York County

Harrisburg, PA – The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) announced today that a resurfacing project is scheduled to begin on Pleasant View Road in Fairview Township, York County. The project limits extend from Sunset Drive to the southbound Interstate 83 off-ramp at Exit 38/Reesers Summit.

Weather permitting, work will begin Monday, September 23. Work will be performed 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM the first week, then nightly from 7:00 PM to 5:00 AM starting Sunday, September 29.

There will be lane closures with flaggers providing traffic control. Motorists should be alert and drive with caution through the work zone.

This project consists of resurfacing, base replacement, minor drainage work, pavement markings, and other miscellaneous construction.

Pennsy Supply, Inc., of Harrisburg is the contractor on this \$703,224 project. All work is expected to be completed by December 4, 2024.
