Meeting called to order by Chair Eric Weber 1600 hrs.

- We welcomed Jill Lancon as our new board member, appointed by council at their last meeting. We also acknowledged the approval of Yankeetown as a CLG on 29 April. Thanks to board members present and past, and town admin who made this possible.
- Previous meeting minutes of 25 Feb 2026 were distributed via e-mail; Terri moved to approve as written, Sally seconded, all voted aye.
- Eric stated he had learned from Tyler Smith, State CLG coordinator they planned on administering on-site training to Yankeetown parties soon, typically within a year of gaining CLG status. Also, virtual training is typically offered every other month, and Tyler mentioned the next webinar will be held on 24 June regarding Secretary of the Interior standards. Tyler also indicated regional-based training should resume next year.
- Terri suggested we try to arrange the above mentioned webinar viewing in the meeting room at Town Hall, this was met with much approval as we all enjoy one another's company and we all need to have an understanding of policy and requirements so we may function as a team. Terri also suggested we have our June meeting after the training, if possible. Eric took contacting Seante regarding this as an action item.
- Eric pondered what we should/could be doing while awaiting much-needed training, and suggested the preparation of a white paper to be sent to townspeople explaining the implications of a structure historic resource designation. Eric vowed to prepare a draft of such and send to board for review and comment.
