Winter Storm Advisory – Plum Borough

Effective: Sunday, January 25 through Monday, January 26

Plum Borough is advising residents of a forecasted major winter storm expected to impact the area from Sunday, January 25 through Monday, January 26. In preparation for this event, the Borough is providing the following important information to ensure public safety and facilitate effective snow-removal operations.

Salt Supply Update

Like many communities across Allegheny County and the region, Plum Borough is currently experiencing a significant salt shortage. The Borough has received approximately 400 tons of a 3,500-ton order that remains outstanding. This is in addition to the approximately 3,000 tons stockpiled from last winter and used during the month of December. Due to this limited supply, salt applications will be prioritized for hills, intersections, and other critical locations to help maintain safe travel conditions. The Borough, in coordination with neighboring communities and suppliers, is actively exploring all available options to replenish salt inventories. Public Works crews will continue plowing operations on all Borough streets throughout the storm.

Snow Event Restrictions:

- **Parking Restrictions:** During a snow event, it is unlawful to park on any Borough Road or within any cul-de-sac posted with “No Parking / Winter Maintenance” signs.
- **Snow Removal Restrictions:** During a snow event, it is unlawful for any person to deposit snow onto the cartway of any Borough street by shoveling, snow blowing, plowing, or by any other means.

Travel Advisory

Residents are strongly encouraged to avoid all unnecessary travel during the storm to allow Public Works crews to safely and efficiently clear roadways.
