

Boil Water Advisory Lifted

Boil Water Advisory to Consumers of Town of Louisa LIFTED

As of , the Boil Water Advisory that was issued 7/27/26 for customers between 107 Ellisville Rd. and 18 N Side Park including Henson Ave., Loving St., and N Side Park..

The Boil Water Advisory was issued after a service interruption and loss of water pressure to customers.

A series of bacteriological samples were collected and sent to a state certified lab. All samples collected on 7/27/26 and 7/28/26 were absent of both total coliform and *E. coli* bacteria in the area where the Boil Water Advisory is currently being lifted.

Following flushing the service line and premise plumbing, residents can safely resume normal use of their tap water.
