Attached is the resolution to approve the 2025 CDBG program which includes the approval of the FY 2025-2029 Five Year Consolidated Plan, FY2025 Annual Action Plan/CDBG Budget and the HOME program allocation for your consideration and approval. Also attached is the executive summary, a summary of the proposed projects for FY 2025 and the minutes from both public hearings.

Penn Hills CDBG consultant Jon Haglund of Urban Design Ventures prepared the Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the 2025 Annual Action Plan, and the executive summary is enclosed. The plan has been on display since June 19, 2025, in the Penn Hills Planning Department, at the Penn Hills Library and at the YMBKQ: De'Avry A. Thomas Center. It also has been available on Penn Hills Website, Penn Hills Facebook Page, the X and on Savvy Citizen.

The Plan is specific to the Penn Hills' Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and will serve as the strategic plan for allocating HUD CDBG funds over the next five years to address the Municipality's housing and community development priority needs. The FY 2025 Annual Action Plan total Budget is \$742,778 which includes a HUD CDBG allocation of \$707,778 and \$35,000 in anticipated program income.

The Municipality is a member of the Allegheny County HOME consortium and will receive a FY 2025 allocation of \$113,373 in HOME funds. Penn Hills will continue to operate the Homebuyers Assistance Program, (HAP), for FY 2025 which is funded with HOME funds. This program has been in operation since 2018 and assists eligible individuals and families with down payment and closing cost assistance toward the purchase of a home. Penn Hills has established a partnership with Action Housing who operates the program for Penn Hills. Penn Hills HAP has assisted approximately 80-85 low- and moderate-income households since 2018.

Two public hearings were held on March 27, 2025, and on June 26, 2025, at the Planning Commission meetings. A notice of each public hearing was advertised in the Post Gazette two weeks prior to the meetings. Input was received from residents, stakeholders, community groups and colleagues concerning the needs of the residents of the Municipality of Penn Hills and the use of CDBG and HOME funds to address those needs over the next five (5) years and the proposed projects for FY 2025 CDBG funding was also discussed.

Penn Hills is required to submit the FY 2025-2029 Five Year Consolidated Plan and FY 2025 Annual Action Plan to HUD on or before August 15, 2025.

Executive Summary

1. Introduction

The Municipality of Penn Hills is an entitlement community under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement Program provides annual grants on a formula basis to entitled cities and counties to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and by expanding economic opportunities, principally for low- and moderate-income persons. The program is authorized under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, Public Law 93-383, as amended; 42 U.S.C.-530.1 et seq. (Source: www.hudexchange.info/programs/cdbg-entitlement)

The Municipality also receives entitlement funds under the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program through the Allegheny County HOME Consortium. The HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) provides formula grants to states and localities that communities use - often in partnership with local nonprofit groups - to fund a wide range of activities including building, buying, and/or rehabilitating affordable housing for rent or homeownership on providing direct rental assistance to low-income people. It is the largest Federal block grant to state and local covernments designed exclusively to create affordable housing for low-income households. (Source: www.hudexchange.info/programs/home)

In compliance with HUD regulation. Penn Hills must prepare a Consolidated Plan every five years to assess its affordable housing, community to element, economic development, and strategic planning needs. The needs and priorities identified in the Consolidated Plan are addressed annually through the Annual Action Plans which prepart what specific activities the Municipality will accomplish with CDBG, HOME, and other funding source. To complete the CDBG program year, the Municipality reports annually on the progress it has made toward its Consolidated Plan goals in the Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER). Pend tills prepared its Five Year Consolidated Plan covering the period of FY 2025, beginning July 1, 2025, through FY 2029, ending June 30, 2030.

2. Summary of the objectives and outcomes identified in the Plan Needs Assessment Overview

The concept of the Consolidated Plan is to serve as a strategic planning document for the Municipality to make data based, market driven, housing and community development plans. Penn Hills' FY 2025-2029 Five Year Consolidated Plan proposes the following six (6) strategies to address the priority needs identified in the Municipality.

Housing Strategy Priority Need: There is a need for decent, safe and sanitary housing that is affordable and accessible to homebuyers, homeowners and renters.

Goals:

- HS-1 Housing Support Assist low- and moderate-income households to access decent, safe and sanitary housing that is affordable and accessible through housing counseling, housing navigator services, rental assistance, and down payment/closing cost assistance.
- HS-2 Housing Construction Encourage the acquisition and construction of new housing that is affordable and accessible.
- HS-3 Housing Rehabilitation Conserve and rehabilitate existing affordable housing units
 occupied by owners, renters, and special needs households in the Municipality by addressing
 maintenance issues, code violations, emergency repairs, accessibility, and home modifications.

Homeless Strategy Priority Need: There is a need for housing and supportive services for the homeless and those at risk of becoming homeless.

Goals:

 HO-1 Operation/Support – Assist partners operating housing or providing supportive services for the homeless and those at-risk of becoming homelessness.

Community Development Strategy Priority New There is a need to improve the community facilities, infrastructure, public services, and quality of life in the Municipality.

Goals:

- CD-1 Community Facilities and mastructure Improve the Municipality's public facilities and infrastructure through a philitation, reconstruction, and new construction.
- CD-2 Public Safety and Services Improve and enhance public safety, public services, and recreational programs, and supportive service programs for persons with special needs.
- CD-3 Clearance/Den dition Remove and eliminate slum and blighting conditions in Penn Hills through code enforcement, clearance, and demolition.

Economic Development Strategy Priority Need: There is a need to encourage employment and economic opportunities in the Municipality.

Goals:

- ED-1 Employment and Development Support and encourage job creation, job retention, job training opportunities, business and commercial growth, and redevelopment of vacant commercial and industrial sites and buildings.
- ED-2 Financial Assistance Support and encourage new economic development through local, state, and federal tax incentives and programs such as: Tax Incremental Financing (TIF); Tax

Abatement (LERTA); Payment in Lieu of Taxes (Pilot); Enterprise Zones/Entitlement Communities; Section 108 Loan Guarantees; Economic Development Initiative (EDI) funds; etc.

Administration, Planning, and Management Strategy Priority Need: There is a need for planning, administration, management, and oversight of federal, state, and local funded programs.

Goals:

AM-1 Overall Coordination — Provide program management and oversight for the successful
administration of federal, state, and local funded programs, including planning services for special
studies, environmental clearance, fair housing activities, and compliance with all federal, state,
and local laws and regulations.

3. Evaluation of past performance

Annually, Penn Hills prepares its Consolidated Annual Performance Evaluation Report (CAPER). This report is submitted within ninety (90) days after the start of the new program year. Copies of the previous program year CAPERs are available for review at the Municipalities Department of Planning Office.

The FY 2023 CAPER, which was the fourth CAPER to the FY 2020-2024 Five Year Consolidated Plan, was approved by HUD in a letter dated October 9, 2024. In the EY 2023 CAPER, the Municipality expended 82.37% of its CDBG funds to benefit low, and moderate-income persons. The Municipality expended 13.59% of its funds during the FY 2028 CALIR period on public service, which complies with the 15% regulatory cap. The Municipality committed 7.04% of its funds during this CAPER period on Planning and Administration, which complies with her 10% regulatory cap. The Municipality's expenditure ratio at the end of the FY 2022 CAPER and was 19, which complies with HUD guidance and is below the 1.5 expenditure ratio maximum. An expenditure ratio over 1.5 could mean the Municipality held too much funding in its line of credit and was no expending in a timely manner.

The Municipality substantial and ded its FY 2019 Annual Action Plan specific to CDBG-CV activities on September 16, 2024. The amendment changed the following activities:

- CDBG-CV Multipurpose Center Ventilation Improvements decrease the line-item budget amount of by \$100,374.55 for a revised total budget amount of \$119,625.45.
- CDBG-CV Senior Center Ventilation Improvements increase the line-item budget amount of by \$40,000 for a revised total budget amount of \$80,000.
- CDBG-CV Mortgage/Rental Assistance increase the line-item budget amount of by \$62,048.52 for a revised total budget amount of \$261,808.52.

4. Summary of citizen participation process and consultation process

The Municipality of Penn Hills followed its Citizen Participation Plan in the planning and preparation of the Five Year Consolidated Plan. The Municipality held its first public hearing to solicit the needs of the community and its residents on Thursday, March 27, 2025. This meeting provided residents and stakeholders the opportunity to discuss the Municipality's CDBG and HOME Programs, as well an opportunity to provide input on the housing and community development needs in the area. The Municipality held its second public hearing to review the draft Five Year Consolidated Plan on June 26, 2025. This provided the residents and stakeholders with the opportunity to discuss the Plan's priority needs, goals, and proposed activities funded with CDBG funds.

The Municipality's Department of Planning and Economic Development maintains a mailing list for its CDBG Program and sends out copies of its public hearing notices and meetings concerning the CDBG Program. Notices are sent to all agencies and individuals who have participated in previous programs and activities.

A copy of the "Draft Five Year Consolidated Plan and the FY 2025 Annual Action Plan" was placed on public display for review by the general public agencies and organizations in the community for a period of 30 days starting on June 19, 2025. A newspaper notice annual these documents were placed on public display was published on June 15, 2025, in the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette, the newspaper of general circulation in the area. The "Draft Five Year Consolidated plantand the FY 2025 Annual Action Plan" were on public display at the following locations:

- There is a need for workforce development programs.
- There is a need for youth and family programs.

- There is a need to address food insecurity among the residents of Penn Hills.
- There is a need for public facility improvements such as community centers and parks.
- There is a need for sidewalks in Penn Hills.

FY2025 Penn Hills CDBG Program

Introduction

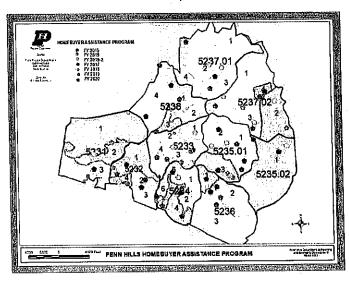
As an entitlement grantee community, the Municipality of Penn Hills receives an annual federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) allocation from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The following is a summary of the proposed activities for Year 51 (FY2025). CDBG projects are to be approved by the Penn Hills Mayor and Council after a formal citizen participation process. The first public hearing took place on Thursday, March 27, 2025, at 7:30 PM and the second hearing was also held Thursday, June 26 at 7:30 PM. Both hearings were held before the Penn Hills Planning Commission. The date for the adoption of the plan by Penn Hills Mayor and Council is scheduled for Monday, July 23, 2025, at 7:00 PM and the plan will be submitted to the HUD on or before August 15, 2025. The release of funds takes place following approval of the Action Plan and approval of environmental reviews by HUD. For FY 2025, the Municipality of Penn Hills expects to receive a CDBG entitlement grant in the amount of \$707,778.00 and program income of \$35,000 for a total budget of \$742,778.00, and a HOME allocation of approximately \$113,373.00 through the Allegheny County HOME Consortium. In order to receive these funds, the Municipality of Penn Hills must prepare a One Year Annual Action Plan for the use of the CDBG funds and a Consolidated Plan every 5 years. At least 70% of the CDBG funds must benefit low and moderate-income people living in the Municipality. The Municipality will be preparing its CDBG application, and it intends to afford residents, local agencies, and interested parties the opportunity to become involved in the planning process.

The order of the projects below is placed in the same order as their prospective Penn Hills account numbers. They are not listed in order of importance. The remaining balances from previous program years include funds from the proposed substantial budget amendment. The following projects will begin immediately upon release of funding. Fiscal Year 25 starts on July 1, 2025 and ends on June 30, 2026.

Housing Counseling Services

The Penn Hills Homebuyer Assistance Program provides downpayment and closing costs to low-income families for the purchase of a home in Penn Hills. The program is funded with HOME funds through a consortium with Allegheny County and McKeesport. HOME allows up to 10% of the funding to be used for The sale of homes administration. through the Homebuver Assistance Program requires a significant amount of work to bring a prospective homebuyer to closing. As a result, we will use the full HOME allocation 113,373.00 to assist homebuyers and fund the housing

counseling and closing services with CDBG funds. Penn Hills provides Action Housing with \$30,000.00 in CDBG funding that assists with the above administrative costs for the operation of the HAP. Since 2018 approximately 85 families have been provided with assistance for the purchase of a home in Penn Hills with the HAP. The map above shows an even distribution of homes that have been purchased throughout Penn Hills with this program, and it illustrates that when given an opportunity, low-income families are able to choose where they want to live.

Cynthia Stotts Community Food Pantry

\$ 15,000.00

This activity was formerly operated as the Lincoln Park Community Center Food Pantry. The Young Black Motivated Kings and Queens Community Center is a non-profit citizen-based organization operating the Cynthia Stotts Community Food Pantry located at 7300 Ridgeview Avenue. For many years this building has housed a wide variety of community and family services including a senior room, a gymnasium, a head start program, a satellite library, meeting rooms, and many other activities. The food bank is one of the many services offered at the YBMKQ Center. A large amount of the Center's pantry supply is purchased from the Greater Pittsburgh Food Bank. The proposed budget is \$15,000.00 for 2025. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment, and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the number of people that now have new access to food and other items that they could not otherwise afford. \$0.00 funding remains from previous program years.

Jefferson Manor Food Pantry

\$ 5,000.00

This activity provides funds for a food pantry to serve the residents of Jefferson Manor. The hi-rise units are operated by the Allegheny County Housing Authority, and all occupants are low-income. The residents receive rent subsidies and are eligible for food stamp programs, but these are deemed to be insufficient. The food pantry



supplements other welfare programs, and by virtue of its first-floor location



in the hi-rise provides a welcome convenience. The budget remains the same for 2025. The Jefferson Manor Food Pantry is located at 201 Jefferson Road. Performance will be measured by the number of people that now have new access to food and other items that couldn't otherwise afford. Fundraisers for the Greater Pittsburgh Food Bank include the Empty Bowls Dinner. (left)

Penn Hills Service Association Food Pantry

These funds are used to purchase food, clothing, and medical supplies for low-income families on a townwide basis. The Penn Hills Service Association has been a sub-recipient of Penn Hills Community Development Block Grant funds for many years. They are a well-organized group of volunteers dedicated to helping the needy. They have provided food, clothing, and medical supplies to deserving families for many years. They supplement these CDBG funds with tag days and other fund-raising efforts. Their

headquarters is located at 2519 Main Street in the Universal Neighborhood, but they serve residents from all parts of the community within their service area. They also purchase supplies for their families from the Greater Pittsburgh Food Bank. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the number of people that now have improved access to food and other items that they couldn't otherwise afford. The funding for 2025 remains the same as last year.

Western Penn Hills Community Action

This program has been operated for the many years by Western Penn Hills Community Action. Low-income youths are employed and put to work on various community projects including cleanup work, landscaping and litter removal. The employees are also provided with mentoring programs designed to broaden the work experience. Local non-profit organizations and the municipality's department directors are free to request that the WPHCA and the employees undertake specific projects in low-income areas. These could

include graffiti removal, litter cleanup, or vegetation control. Recent discussion about the amount of litter in various locations and possible neighborhood projects has generated a request to spend more time on litter clean up and special projects than clearing vegetation from vacant lots in the coming year. Although the program operates out of the First Baptist Church in Penn Hills on Chadwick Street, this is a town wide program. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment and the outcome is sustainability. Performance will be measured by the number of people that now have new access to this program to provide a suitable living environment. No funding remains from previous years.

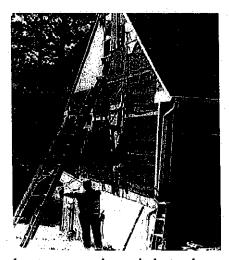


Ruth's Way is an Achievement Consulting Agency for Adolescent Girls, which strives to empower female youth to achieve their most successful futures possible, despite their past or current situation. Ruth's Way, Inc. is a faith-based, family-operated and family-oriented, nonprofit organization that assists female youth ages 10-17 to achieve their most successful futures possible, despite their past or current

situation. All of their programs and services are carried out from a strengths-based perspective which supports our young ladies and their families being in control of their own processes and outcomes. The National Objective is to benefit limited clientele, and the objective is to provide suitable living environments and outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the number of young women that have new access to this program that could not otherwise been able to attend. No funding remains from previous years.

Single Family Rehabilitation Program

\$52,000.00



This program provides 0% loans to qualifying low-income homeowners. Because the interest rates are so low at this time, we are considering reducing the interest rate to 0%. Repayment of loans provides an estimated \$35,000 of program income each year which is put back into the program. A matching grant of up to \$2,500.00 is available for accessible improvements. We offer this program to low and moderate income homeowners and encourage them to make necessary improvements to their homes. We assist homeowners in the application and bidding process. We process applications, prepare bid specifications and monitor construction through the Municipality's Housing Coordinator. During the life of the CDBG program we

have approved, carried out the work, and satisfied over 700 loans. The objective is to provide decent housing and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the number of families no longer living in substandard housing. No available funding remains in the budget from previous program years. Existing applications will result in the expending of existing funds prior to the end of the program year.



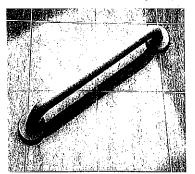
Funds from this activity will be used to provide \$1,000.00 grants to low-income senior citizens to assist them with upgrades to improve their quality of life. Typical Senior Aid Rehab activities include accessibility improvements such as grab bars and handrails, electrical upgrades including a new electrical service, and other lower cost items. For activities in excess of \$1,000.00 the applicant can receive the grant and simply pay the difference. Qualifying participants have taken

advantage of both the single-family rehab program and the Senior Aid Rehab program. This is a very popular program. The objective is to provide decent housing, and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the number of families no longer living in substandard housing.

Senior Handrail Program

\$10,778.00

Funds from this activity are used to provide grants to low-income senior citizens to assist



them with upgrades to improve their quality of life. The Senior Service Center operated a successful handrail program for several years before handing it over to the Planning Department. This activity will enhance our already successful rehab programs and assist senior residents in making their homes safer. Funds from this activity were used to install handrails in approximately 40 low-income senior households per year. The objective is to provide decent housing and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the

number of families no longer living in substandard housing. No funding remains from previous program years.

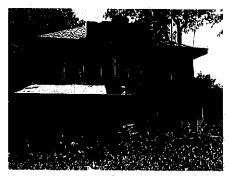
Townwide Demolition

\$100,000.00

In combination with rehabilitation program, the removal of unsafe and deteriorated structures is a very important part of the Municipality's effort to eliminate slums and blight. When owners of deteriorated structures cannot be located and successfully prosecuted, or when owners are low-income individuals that cannot afford to remove the violation themselves, we will demolish the structure with CDBG funds. Specific guidelines are carried out to attempt to locate the owner or their heirs prior to bidding out the



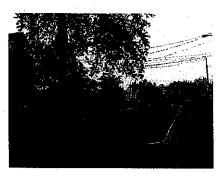
demolition. Once the property is demolished, a lien is placed on the property so future recovery of costs is possible. This program operates on a town wide basis. These funds can also be used to remove retaining walls, debris, and accessory structures as well as for the reestablishment of appropriate lawns or vegetation.



Penn Hills expends nearly \$100,000.00 per year on the demolition of unsafe structures and will continue to do so at a similar pace. There is a cap on the amount of funds to be spent on the demolition. It is not a low-mod activity. Demolition does not meet the National Objective of benefit to low-mod residents. Although the structures are removed, Penn Hills does not own the land. We are removing a code violation and unsafe condition. Maintenance of the vacant lot is still the responsibility of the landowner. Many

residents in the vicinity of these lots would like to see these vacant lots maintained as lawn. Although our specifications require that the contractor fine grade the property and rake to establish a surface suitable for mowing, Penn Hills does not have the resources to mow these lots and there is no ordinance that requires owners of vacant property to maintain it as lawn. In fact, the opposite is true. Land is to remain wooded until a development proposal is approved. As long as no development proposal or building permit is obtained, these sites may return to woodland. This activity qualifies under Removal of Slum and Blight. It is not a low/mod income activity. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment and the outcome is sustainability. Outcome performance is measured by the number of unsafe structures removed through this activity.

Street Reconstruction



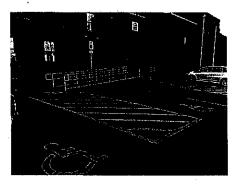

program is designed to provide street reconstruction in low-income neighborhoods throughout the municipality. We have essentially caught up with deteriorated streets in eligible neighborhoods and can now pave on a standard cycle. Street reconstruction is intended to benefit the quality of life in these neighborhoods by improving the physical environment. These improvements add value to the homes in the area and hopefully encourage home ownership. rehabilitation activity,

construction. This is not a significant amount of funding when it comes to the cost of street reconstruction. This activity serves low-income areas town-wide. The Superintendent of Public Works and his staff have identified streets in need of reconstruction and prepared a list for the chart below. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment and the outcome is sustainability. Performance for this activity will be measured by the number of people that no longer have access to only substandard streets as a result of the improvements.

Accessible Improvements

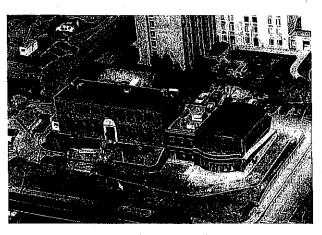

These funds will be used to provide accessible improvements and to remove architectural barriers from municipal buildings and public facilities. This activity is in response to a monitoring visit from HUD where various barriers to access municipal buildings were pointed out. The monitoring resulted in a Voluntary Compliance Agreement that requires specific accessible improvements and upgrades be constructed. These funds will be used to make accessible improvements at the William McKinley

Center. These improvements will include the installation of accessible restrooms at the William McKinley Center. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the number of people that no longer have access to a substandard facility as a result of the improvement.

Senior Service Center Improvements

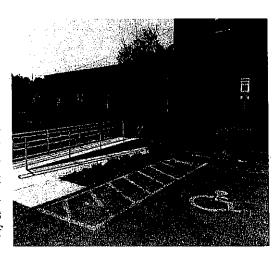
The Senior Service Center has requested funding for a variety of projects. The Center is located at 147 Jefferson Road in Penn Hills. Each project is given a level of priority by the Director of the Senior Service Center. Priorities include safety and security improvements to the lobby and computer system improvements. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance in this activity will be

measured by the number of people that no longer have access to only a substandard facility as a result of this improvement. This year's funds may be used to replace several windows and the door to the kitchen located on the addition portion of the senior center building. We also will have Penn Hills Municipal Engineer investigate the problems with the leaking windows prior to the new ones being installed.

William McKinley Improvements

This activity will fund ongoing improvements at the William McKinley Center. The \$20,000.00 proposed for 2024 will be used to provide interior accessible improvements including restrooms. This work is required as part of a Voluntary Compliance Agreement with HUD. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment, and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the number of people that no longer only have access to a substandard facility as a result of the improvement. This years project may include the replacement of the water lines that lead to the boiler.

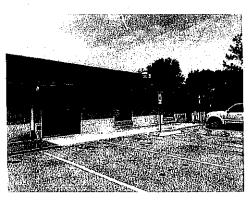

Multi-Purpose Center Improvements

These funds will be used to make improvements to the Penn Hills Multi-Purpose Center at 2025 Lincoln Road. Funds from this activity will be used to make additional interior UFAS improvements to the kitchen area. Accessible improvements will include accessible kitchen appliances as required by the Voluntary Compliance Agreement described above. Recent improvements include accessible restrooms,

exterior doors,





thresholds, sidewalks and ramps. The objective is to provide a suitable living environment, and the outcome is availability and accessibility. Performance will be measured by the number of people that no longer only have access to a substandard facility as a result of the improvement. No funding remains from previous program years. This year's project will include the replacement of 5 breaker boxes at the center that are unsafe.

General Program Administration

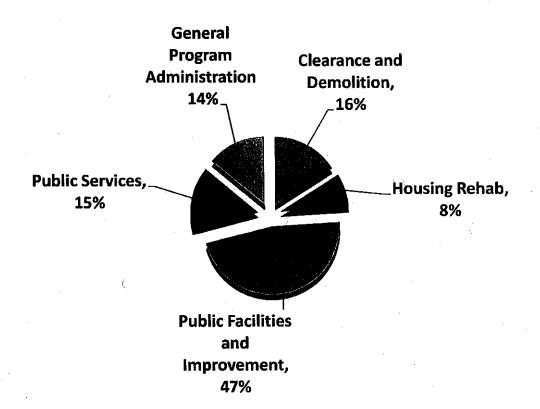
General Program Administration (GPA) is used for consulting costs, salaries, legal fees, advertising, computer hardware and software, office supplies, salaries, and other administrative costs incurred by the Planning Department in its operation of the CDBG Program. Other incidental costs may be charged to this account including training, travel expenses, and many other special needs related to the administration of the program. Penn Hills is permitted to use up to 20% of the CDBG expenditures for administration. The FY 2025 budget will utilize approximately 13% of the budget on administration. This means that 86% of the Penn Hills CDBG funds are used to accomplish the goals of the CDBG program which is the benefit to low-income people. In the future the Municipality is hoping to hire a CDBG Coordinator to administer the CDBG Program. This will allow us to better serve Penn Hills' low-income residents and free up time for the Planning Department staff to focus on grant writing and other planning department functions.

Conclusion

The Penn Hills Department of Planning and Economic Development are assigned the primary responsibility for the day-to-day implementation of the Penn Hills Community Development Block Grant Program. The staff maintains an ongoing relationship with both sub-recipients and HUD representatives and maintains project records. Each year with the help of consultants we prepare the Action plan to apply for funding and prepare the Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) to report on the year's expenditures and performance. Ms: King presented: FY 2025; YEAR 51, CDBG ANNUAL ACTION PLAN and 5 YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN = First Public Hearing:

The first public hearing for the discussion of Penn Hills Community Development Block Grant, (CDBG), Program and the HOME Investment Partnerships Program is scheduled for the March 27, 2025, Planning Commission Meeting. This year the Municipality is preparing its Five-Year consolidated Plan, FY 2025-2029 and the FY 2025 Annual Action Plan. The purpose of this meeting is to receive input from residents, stakeholders, community groups and colleagues concerning the needs of the residents of the Municipality of Penn Hills and the use of CDBG and HOME funds to address those needs over the next five (5) years. We are asking for participation to discuss the housing, homelessness, community development, economic development, administrative planning and other special needs which will be incorporated into the Municipality's Five-Year Consolidated Plan. (2025-2029) and its 2025 Annual Action Plan. Penn Hills qualifies as an entitlement community and has received CDBG funds from the U. S. Department of HUD for the last 51 years. This determination is made based on the population of Penn Hills and on the annual income of its residents.

The HOME Investment Partnership Program is operated through the Allegheny County HOME Consortium, consisting of Allegheny County as the lead agency, the Municipality of Penn Hills and the City of McKeesport as participants. After determining that there is a need to provide home ownership opportunities to low- and moderate-income persons and families, Penn Hills began the Homebuyers Assistance Program, (HAP) in 2018. This program assists eligible individuals and families with down payment and closing cost assistance. Penn Hills has established a partnership with Action Housing who operates the program for Penn Hills. Penn Hills HAP has assisted approximately 75 low- and moderate-income households since 2018.

I have enclosed the Public Hearing Notice for the meeting, an email/letter that I sent to community groups and interested residents inviting them to participate in the preparation of the Action Plan/5 Year Consolidated Plan, a Comments and Suggestion Form for them to complete and a copy of a flyer encouraging residents to participate in a survey that was prepared by our CDBG consultant, Jon Haglund of Urban Design Ventures for your information. The flyer will also be posted on Penn Hills Website and on Penn Hills Facebook page, the X and on Savvy Citizen.

The CDBG projects from this past year are funding public service program allocations to three (3) Food Pantries in Penn Hills, the Western Penn Hills Community Action Youth Employment Program, Ruth's Way, and a Housing Counseling Program for administrative costs for the Homebuyers Assistance Program. Other projects funded were the Senior Aid Grant Program, the Housing Rehabilitation Loan Program, the Senior Services Center

Handrail Program, the Demolition Program, the Street Reconstruction Program, Accessible Building Improvements and improvements to the Senior Service Center, the William McKinley Community Center, the Multi-Purpose Center and the YBMKQ Community Center, (formerly the Lincoln Park Community Center).

The motion was seconded by Mr. Brodnicki. There were no objections from the audience.

The minutes were approved by a 4 - 0 vote.

Ms. King presented: SITE PLAN # 546: 2ND MODIFICATION to waive the Performance Bond to

the Municipality at the end of Phase 1.

The applicant, Victor Rodriguez of Northwood Commons, LLC.,100 West Station Square Drive, Suite 350, Pittsburgh., PA owner of the property located on Penn Pleasant Drive, is requesting a 2nd modification to the previously approved Site Plan #546 for the phase one portion of a multifamily development. The applicant is requesting that a portion of condition #1 of the Planning Commission decision approved at the 10/26/23 meeting be removed. The approved condition states the following: "The applicant shall submit a performance bond to the Municipality at the end of phase 1 construction that is 110% of the cost of the construction of the remaining extension of Penn Pleasant Drive that will include the construction of the cul-de-sac and will be constructed during phase 2 of the Northwood Commons Project. The bond shall be submitted prior to the issuance of the occupancy permits for the apartments constructed during phase 1." The applicant is asking that the bond not be required for the construction of the cul-de-sac. The Zoning Classification is R-5, Multi-Family Residential and the lot and block numbers are 537-M-

87 and 536-R-241. Penn Hills Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance 2136, Penn Hills Zoning Ordinance 2420, and Penn Hills Stormwater Management Ordinance 2642 of 2019 apply.

- 1. To waive the performance bond to the Municipality at the end of phase 1 construction. This would be a 110% increase in the cost of construction that is remaining for the extension of Penn Pleasant Drive that will include the construction of the cul-de-sac that will be constructed during phase 2 of the Northwood Commons Project. Rodriguez and Associates have provided a letter of support from their insurance agent describing the hardship they are facing obtaining the performance bond at the present time. Please see attached.
- 2. The temporary hammerhead that will be constructed during phase 1 provides sufficient area for emergency vehicles including fire trucks for ingress and egress of the site and it meets the International Fire Code for adequate turnaround. The current insurance/bonding requirements and the uncertainty of the timing for future LIHTC and other government funding sources, make it extremely difficult and expensive to bind the future permanent cul-de-sac improvements for phase 2. We fully intend to develop phase 2; the timing of the construction is unknown. However, applications for funding phase 2 are expected to be submitted come February 2026.

The plans for the proposed hammerhead have been reviewed by the Fire Marshal. He has no objections to this request if it is only temporary.

The Planning Department has taken pictures of the current state of the construction site. Please refer to the attached. As of 6/5/2025, the temporary hammerhead has yet to be installed.

The Planning Department recommends approval of the request for the 2nd modification to Site Plan #546 with conditions and offers the following motion:

Motion #1:

I recommend approval of the request for the 2nd modification to Site Plan #546 for the construction of the Northwood Commons Multi-Family Development and allow the applicant to request a waiver of bond for construction of the permanent cul-de-sac until future funding has been secured with the following conditions.

 Rodriguez Associates has provided an email outlining the concerns that the cul-de-sac would not be constructed. The concerns have been outlined as follows:

- Rodriguez Associates has already spent significant funds for the 2nd phase civil engineering design, which has been approved by the Township and fully plans to complete Phase 2.
- There is no benefit to not developing the site and paying taxes on the vacant land in perpetuity.
- The property will operate in a much more cost-effective manner with an additional 28 units from phase 2 as the expenses can be shared over 68 apartments units.
- The two primary funders, PHFA and Allegheny County Department of Economic Development, have a vested interest in seeing the second phase developed and prioritize affordable apartment units for working families-the primary clientele that Northwood Commons will serve.
- We plan to submit to PHFA for the 2nd Phase funding on the next application cycle, which is tentatively February 2026. (PHFA prefers that the first phase be completed and leased up prior to the next funding request.)

Site Plan# 546 - Northwood Commons: Additional Condition for the 2nd Modification Request to previously approved site plan:

2. Following the applicant's submittal of the funding application(s) in 2026, the applicant shall notify the Penn Hills Planning Department in writing when a determination has been made by the PA Housing Finance Agency, (PHFA), and Allegheny County Economic Development, (ACED) regarding the funding for the Phase 2 portion of the project. It is expected that the determination will be made later in 2026 or early in 2027. If the Phase 2 portion of the project to construct the 28 townhouses is not funded, the applicant shall be required to submit a bond that is 110% of the cost to convert the existing hammerhead to a Cul-De-Sac. The bond shall be submitted within 30 days of the date of the notification from PHFA and ACED not to fund the project and the existing Hammerhead shall be converted to a Cul-De-Sac no later than 90 days following the notification from PHFA and ACED not to fund the project.

Addendum to **Ms. King** motion. For clarification Ms. King reiterated the additional condition for the second modification to the request:

Following the applicant's submittal of the funding application(s) in 2026, the applicant shall notify the Penn Hills Planning Department in writing when a determination has been made by the PA Housing Finance Agency, (PHFA), and Allegheny County Economic Development, (ACED) regarding the funding for the Phase 2 portion of the project. It is expected that the determination will be made later in 2026 or early in 2027. If the Phase 2 portion of the project to construct the 28 townhouses is not funded, the applicant shall be required to submit a bond that is 110% of the cost to convert the existing hammerhead to a Cul-De-Sac. The CDBG proposed projects for the FY 2025, (July1, 2025 - June 30, 2026) will fund public service program allocations to three (3) Food Pantries in Penn Hills, the Western Penn Hills Community Action Youth Employment Program, Ruth's Way, and a Housing Counseling Program for administrative costs for the Homebuyers Assistance Program. Other projects to be funded the Senior Aid Grant Program, the Housing Rehabilitation Loan Program, the Senior Services Center Handrail Program, the Demolition Program, the Street Reconstruction Program, Accessible Building Improvements and improvements to the Senior Service Center, the Wm. McKinley Community Center, the Multi-Purpose Center and the YBMKQ Community Center, (formerly the Lincoln Park Community Center).

As you know, the first public hearing for the discussion of Penn Hills Community Development Block Grant, (CDBG), Program and the HOME Investment Partnerships Program was held at your March 27, 2025, Planning Commission Meeting.

Input was received from residents, stakeholders, community groups and colleagues concerning the needs of the residents of the Municipality of Penn Hills and the use of CDBG and HOME funds to address those needs over the next five (5) years and the FY 2025 CDBG funding was also discussed. There were requests for funding for the upcoming CDBG FY 2025, July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2025. HUD CDBG regulations only allow public services to be15% of the annual budget and the current funding rate is at 14.1% which would mean that if Penn Hills were to fund another public service organization, we would have to reduce the funding of the current subrecipients and there is no reason to do that because the programs that are currently being provided provide essential services to Penn Hills residents. A copy of the minutes from the meeting are enclosed for your information.

We are required to have two (2) public hearings and the final adoption a year.

We received from HUD an increase in funding in the amount of \$7,000.

Several non-profit groups requested funding at the 1st public hearing held on 3/27/2025. To fund them we must take funds from other recipients, which is not fair to them, and the service we provide for the residents. We have the same programs as last year refer to "Attachment A" budget proposal in your packet.

The lights went out in the building during the meeting due to the rainstorm outside.

The Lincoln Park Multi-Purpose Center has a Daycare in the building and rents the halls, fields and park pavilions for events.

The demolition of houses is done in conjunction with the Code Enforcement & Planning Departments, and complaints from the residents.

YBMKQ ask for more funds but is happy with the \$15,000 they will receive.

Restrooms & gym renovations, the Engineer and the Planning Dept will coordinate.

<u>Greg Swatchick</u> of 648 Gramac Ln. – commented on managing and maintaining the fund, five (5) year plan.

Emergency repairs – Penn Hills Council.

FY 2025, YEAR 51 next step is to go before the Mayor & Council at the July 2025 meeting.

A motion was made by Ms. King to adjourn the meeting.

The motion was seconded by Dr. Kincaid.

Ordinance No. 2707 of 2025

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF PENN HILLS, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A VOLUNTEER SERVICE CREDIT PROGRAM; ENACTING TAX CREDITS FOR VOLUNTEER MEMBERS OF VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANIES AND NONPROFIT EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE AGENCY; AND ESTABLISHING ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES AND APPEALS

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

The following words and phrases when used in this ordinance shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise.

- "Active Volunteer." A volunteer for a volunteer fire company or nonprofit emergency medical service agency listed under Section 2(c) who has complied with, and is certified under, the Volunteer Service Credit Program.
- "Earned Income Tax." A tax on earned income and net profits levied under Chapter 3 of the act of December 31, 1965 (P.L.1257, No.511), known as The Local Tax Enabling Act.
- "Eligibility Period." The timeframe when volunteers may earn credit under the Volunteer Service Credit Program.
- "Emergency Responder." A volunteer who responds to an emergency call with one of the entities listed under Section 2(c).
- "Emergency Response Call." Any emergency call to which a volunteer responds, including travel directly from and to a volunteer's home, place of business or other place where he/she shall have been when the call was received.
- "Qualified Real Property." A residential real property owned and occupied as the domicile of an active volunteer.

"Volunteer." A member of a volunteer fire company or a nonprofit emergency medical service agency.

SECTION 2. VOLUNTEER SERVICE CREDIT PROGRAM.

- A) Establishment. Penn Hills Municipality hereby establishes a Volunteer Service Credit Program. The goal of the program is to encourage membership and service in the community's volunteer fire companies and nonprofit emergency medical service agencies.
- B) Program Criteria. The Board shall establish, by resolution, the annual criteria that must be met to qualify for credits under the program based on the following:
 - (1) The number of emergency response calls to which a volunteer responds.
 - (2) The level of training and participation in formal training and drills for a volunteer.
 - (3) The total amount of time expended by a volunteer on administrative and other support services, including but not limited to:
 - (i) fundraising
 - (ii) providing facility or equipment maintenance
 - (iii) financial bookkeeping
 - The involvement in other events or projects that aid the financial viability, emergency response or operational readiness of a volunteer fire company or a nonprofit emergency medical service agency.
 - (5) The total number of years the volunteer has served.
- C) Eligible Entities. The Volunteer Service Credit Program is available to residents of the township who are volunteers of the following volunteer fire companies and nonprofit emergency medical service agencies that provide service to Penn Hills Municipality:

PENN HILLS VFD #5 (225) (Thad Stevens) Robinson Blvd Pittsburgh, PA 15235
PENN HILLS VFD #7 (227) (Universal) 2240 Main Street Pittsburgh, PA 15235

D) Eligibility Period. A volunteer must meet the minimum criteria, set by resolution under this section, during the eligibility period to qualify for the tax credits established under Section 3.

- (1) For 20 25, the eligibility period under the Volunteer Service Credit Program shall run from January 1, 2025, until December 1, 2025. [Note: *The end date shall be more than 45 days before the tax bills are sent.*]
- (2) For 2025, and each subsequent year thereafter, the eligibility period shall run from January 1 st until December 1st.
- E) Recordkeeping. The chief of each volunteer fire company or the supervisor of the nonprofit emergency medical service agency listed under Section 2(c) shall keep specific records of each volunteer's activities in a service log to establish credits under the Volunteer Service Credit Program. Service logs shall be subject to review by the Board of Supervisors, the State Fire Commissioner and the State Auditor General. The chief, or supervisor, shall amrnally transmit to the Township a notarized eligibility list of all volunteers that have met the minimum criteria for the Volunteer Service Credit Program. The notarized eligibility list shall be transmitted to the Township no later than November 1 of each year. The chief or supervisor shall post the notarized eligibility list in an accessible area of the volunteer agency's facilities. [Note: Act 1 72 states the eligibility list must be transmitted to the township no later than 45 days before the tax notice is sent. Tax notices could be sent as early as January 15".]
- F) Application. Volunteers that have met the minimum criteria of the Volunteer Service Credit Program shall sign and submit an application for certification to their chief or supervisor. The chief or supervisor shall sign the application if the volunteer has met the minimum criteria of the Volunteer Service Credit Program, and forward it to the township secretary. Applications shall not be accepted by the township after April 1st of each year.
- G) Municipal Review. The township secretary shall review the applications for credit under the Volunteer Service Credit Program and shall cross reference them with the notarized eligibility list. The Board of Supervisors shall approve all applicants that are on the notarized eligibility list. All applicants approved by the Board of Supervisors shall be issued a tax credit certificate by the Township Secretary.
- H) Official Tax Credit Register. The Township shall keep an official Tax Credit Register of all active volunteers that were issued tax credit certificates. The township secretary shall issue updates, as needed, of the official Tax Credit Register to the following:
 - (I) Board of Supervisors;
 - (2) Chief of the volunteer fire company
 - (3) Chief or supervisor of the nonprofit emergency medical services agency

(4) Tax officer for the township Tax Collection District [Note: If Earned Income Tax Credit is enacted]

1) Injured Volunteers.

- (1) An emergency responder that is injured during an emergency response call may be eligible for future tax credits. The injury must have occurred while responding to, participating in, or returning from an emergency response call with one of the entities listed under Section 2(c).
- An injured emergency responder shall provide documentation from a licensed physician with the application required under Section 2 stating that their injury prevents them from performing duties to qualify as an active volunteer. In such a case, the injured emergency responder shall be deemed an active volunteer for that tax year.
- (3) An injured emergency responder shall annually submit the application required under Section 2, along with updated documentation from a licensed physician stating that the injury still exists and prevents them from qualifying as an active volunteer. The injured emergency responder shall again be deemed an active volunteer for that tax year. An injured emergency responder shall only be deemed an active volunteer for a maximum of five consecutive tax years.

SECTION 3. EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT.

A) Tax Credit. Each active volunteer who has been certified under the Municipality of Penn Hills Volunteer Service Credit Program shall be eligible to receive a tax credit of up to \$250 of the Earned Income Tax levied by the municipality. When an active volunteer's earned income tax liability is less than the amount of the tax credit, the tax credit shall equal the individual's tax liability.

B) Claim.

(1) An active volunteer with a tax credit certificate may file a claim for the tax credit on their township earned income tax liability. When filing a final return for the preceding calendar year with the tax officer for the Allegheny Southeast Tax Collection District.

B) Rejection of Tax Credit Claim.

(1) The tax officer shall reject a claim for a tax credit if the taxpayer is not on the official Tax Credit Register issued by the township secretary.

- (2) If the tax officer rejects the claim, the taxpayer shall be notified in writing of the decision. The notice shall include the reasons for the rejection and provide the method of appealing the decision pursuant to Section 5.
- (3) Taxpayers shall have 30 days to appeal the decision of the tax officer.

SECTION 4. REAL PROPERTY TAX CREDIT.

A) Tax Credit. Each active volunteer who does not qualify under §3, but who is an Emergency Responder, and who has been certified under Municipality of Penn Hills Volunteer Service Credit Program shall be eligible to receive a real property tax credit of \$250

B) Claim.

- (1) An active volunteer with a tax credit certificate may file a claim for the tax credit on their qualified real property tax liability for the township's real estate tax levy. The tax credit shall be administered as a refund by the Municipal Finance office. An active volunteer shall file the following with the Municipality
 - (i) A true and correct receipt from the township real estate tax collector of the paid township real property taxes for the tax year which the claim is being filed.
 - (ii) The tax credit certificate.
 - (iii) Photo identification.
 - (iv) Documentation that the tax paid was for qualified real property as defined in this ordinance.
- (2) If the active volunteer provides all documents required under this subsection and is otherwise not eligible for a wage tax credit, then the Municipality shall issue a property tax refund to the active volunteer.

C) Rejection of the Tax Credit Claim.

(1) The township secretary shall reject the claim for a township real property tax credit if the taxpayer fails to provide the documents required under subsection (B)(I).

- (2) If the township secretaryy rejects the claim, the taxpayer shall be notified in writing of the decision. The notice shall include the reasons for the rejection and provide the method of appealing the decision pursuant to Section 5.
- (3) Taxpayers shall have 30 days to appeal the decision of the township secretary.

SECTION 5, APPEALS.

A) Earned Income Tax Credit Appeals.

- (1) Any taxpayer aggrieved by a decision under Section 3 shall have a right to appeal said decision.
- (2) A taxpayer shall have 30 days to appeal a decision or rejection of claim.
- (3) All appeals of decisions under Section 3 shall follow the provisions of the Act of May 5, 1998, P.L.301, No. 50, known as the Local Taxpayers Bill of Rights.
- (4) [Note: Reference the procedure identified by the township's Local Taxpayer Bill of Rights ordinance]

B) Real Property Tax Credit Appeals.

- (1) Any taxpayer aggrieved by a decision under Section 4 shall have a right to appeal said decision.
- (2) A taxpayer shall have 30 days to appeal a decision or rejection of claim.
- (3) All appeals under Section 4 shall follow the provisions of 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5, Subchapter B (relating to practice and procedure of local agencies), and 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 7, Subchapter B (relating to judicial review of local agency action), also known as the "Local Agency Law."

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.

In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause, or part of this Ordinance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of the Ordinance, it being the intent of the Municipality of Penn Hills that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect and for this purpose the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.
