



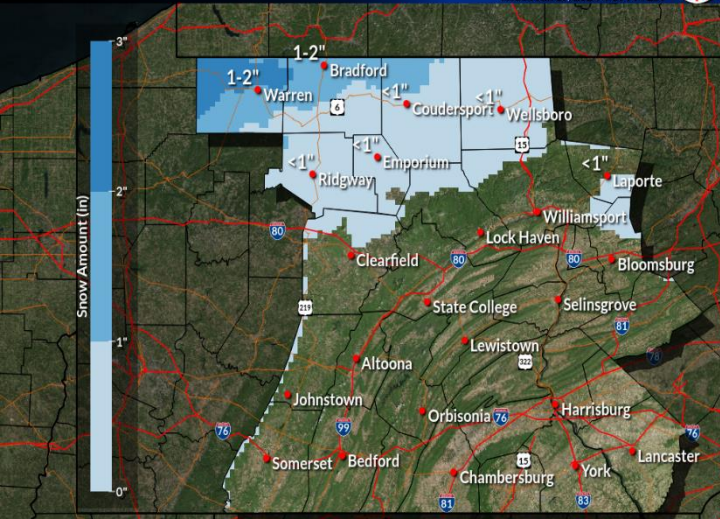
OVERVIEW:

- Light snow is possible today across the northern tier, with a coating to 2 inches of accumulation. Highest totals expected in Warren and McKean Co.
- Widespread accumulating snowfall is likely Friday, with amounts generally ranging 2-4 inches with higher amounts expected across the Laurels.

| ADDITIONAL INFORMATION | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A reasonable worst case scenario for the Friday system would bring 5-6 inches of snow to portions of central PA (1-in-10 chance of exceeding these numbers)▪ A dry, powdery snow is expected given the cold temperatures |
| NWS ALERTS | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Storm Warning is in effect for Somerset county for Friday morning through Saturday morning.▪ Winter Weather Advisory is in effect for most of central PA for Friday. |
| POST-EVENT OUTLOOK | <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Another shot of cold air will follow behind the departing storm Fri night into Saturday, expect dropping wind chills. |
