

Youngwood Borough is asking for your patience during an alley reclamation/paving project on the **alleys between 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Street from Chestnut Street through Lowe Street.**

This is a \$165,500 project funded by a Community Development and Block Grant and the Borough. If you live in the area of the project, you may recall that you needed to complete an income survey. This project is the result of the completion of the surveys. To those of you who completed the surveys, we say "Thank you" for working with the Borough!

We definitely understand it is an inconvenience, but the work needs to be done.

Tresco Paving, the contractor for Youngwood Borough, will be starting the project on Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>. The **alleys between 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Street from Chestnut Street through Lowe Street** will be closed from Tuesday, September 5<sup>th</sup> through Friday, September 8<sup>th</sup>. The alley will then be re-opened Friday evening and remain open through Wednesday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. On Thursday, September 14<sup>th</sup>

and Friday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, the alley will then be closed again for paving.

During the **alley closures only**, you may park on both sides of South 5<sup>th</sup> Street from Chestnut Street to Lowe Street. In addition, during **alley closures only**, you may park on both sides of Locust Street, Newill Street and Lowe Street. WE do remind you that school buses do traverse these streets do not park close to any of the intersections.

Again, we do know it is definitely an inconvenience, but please be patient as the finished project will be worth it!
