AMENDMENT TO THE CITY CODE CHAPTER 256 TITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 256 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF LATROBE, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA- TITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC AMENDING AND CORRECTING VARIOUS SCHEDULES OF ARTICLE VII

WHEREAS, the City of Latrobe maintains the city code Chapter 256 titled Vehicles and Traffic which includes traffic regulations, parking regulations, metered and permit parking regulations, and Schedules for vehicle, traffic and parking activities and operations in the City of Latrobe which was originally adopted on July 13, 1981 and amended on February 8, 1993; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to amend the Code specifically updating and correcting the Schedules of Chapter 256 Article VII section 256-46 through section 256-63 deleting outdated language and making corrections and updates to current streets, traffic and parking operations and,

WHEREAS, the City is supportive of efforts to keep the city code maintained in good order; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the City of Latrobe, and the City of Latrobe hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. That the Schedules of Chapter 256 Article VII Section 256-46 through section 256-63 be updated and corrected to current street, traffic and parking operations as outlined on the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. That all other provisions of Section 256 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That the within Ordinance shall take effect on the date of publication of the post enactment notice of passage of the same and no later than June 1, 2026.

Section 4. That the City Manager, The City Secretary, Mayor and any other proper City official is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents and to take any action necessary in order to carry in effect the within ordinance.
