CONTRACT EXTENSION

The Successful Bidder and the Township may mutually agree to extend the Contract for a total of not more than One (1) additional year. The cost for monthly services charged by the Successful Bidder in any extension year shall increase no more than the following percentages. Such percentages shall be applied to the monthly costs for services listed by the Successful Bidder in its bid. Such percentages increases shall not be applied to changes in monthly costs due to the Vehicle Fuel Adjustor or increases in monthly costs due to increased tipping fee charges for MSW, as may be instituted by the County for the Harrisburg Incinerator.

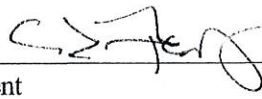

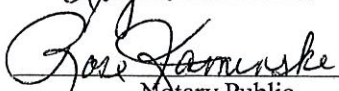

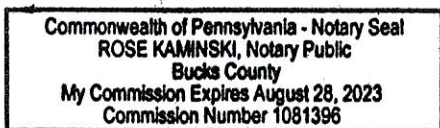
