Joint EMS Authority Meeting Rescheduled

Tarentum, PA — The joint EMS informational meeting scheduled for tomorrow, January 14, 2026, has been **rescheduled**. Highlands High School notified us yesterday that they are actively preparing the stage and auditorium for their upcoming school musical and are unable to accommodate all of our setup requirements during the setup period.

“We fully understand and respect the amount of time, effort, and coordination that goes into a production of this size,” said Borough Manager Dwight Boddorf. “The students, staff, and volunteers put an incredible amount of work into showcasing their talents, and we don’t want to disrupt their progress.”

A new meeting date will be announced shortly once an alternate time or venue is secured. All three municipalities will also prepare a proper re-advertisement for the rescheduled meeting to ensure full compliance and clear public notice.

In the meantime, residents are encouraged to continue providing feedback, ask questions, and share input on the EMS Authority proposal. The additional time between now and the next meeting gives the public further opportunity to be heard and to engage in the process.

The EMS Steering Committee extends sincere appreciation to Highlands High School for its continued partnership and for allowing the use of its facilities throughout this entire process. Their support has been invaluable as we work through this complex regional effort.

“We wish the students and the entire musical production team the very best of luck,” Boddorf added. “Their hard work brings great pride to our community.”
