According to Florida Statute 286.011, also known as the "Sunshine Law," commissioners can attend social events together, but they cannot discuss official business matters at those gatherings if the topics are likely to come up for a vote at a future commission meeting; essentially, any discussion of official business at a social event between commissioners would need to be held in a public meeting to comply with the law.

Key points about the Sunshine Law and commissioners at social events:

No official business discussion:

Commissioners can attend social events together, but they should avoid discussing any matters that might come up for a vote at a future commission meeting.

Public notice requirement:

If a gathering of commissioners could be considered a "meeting" due to discussion of official business, it would need to be held with proper public notice.

Intent to avoid conflicts of interest:

The Sunshine Law is designed to ensure transparency and prevent situations where commissioners could make decisions behind closed doors.
