Little Conewago Creek Restoration Project Funding Rescinded

The \$5.83 million grant that was awarded to Dover Township from the FEMA/Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant Fund has been rescinded due to cuts with the Federal Emergency Management Agency. Therefore, this joint project involving both West Manchester and Dover Townships will not move forward unless additional funding is made available. Staff is currently working to finalize the permitting & will continue to write grant applications to ensure this project is completed as it will mitigate flooding issues along the Little Conewago Creek between the two communities.



Dover Township Welcomes our First Full-time Emergency Services Coordinator

Justin Eberly joined the staff of Dover Township on July 28th, 2025. This is a position that is intended to manage emergency response during large natural and man-made disasters, such as flooding, blizzards and other large-scale incidents. In addition, Mr. Eberly is tasked with strategic and capital planning efforts to ensure that emergency services, fire and EMS, are considered as the Township grows and volunteerism in Fire Services lessens. Dover Township is serviced by a 100% Volunteer Fire Department and a non-profit ambulance organization, which can at times make operations difficult. It is our hope that Mr. Eberly will be able to assist these services in making the best use of their funding in order to continue to provide excellent service to the greater Dover area. Board of Supervisors

The Board of Supervisors will hold their regular meetings in the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 6:00 PM on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Mondays of the month. The Dover Township Board of Supervisors invites the public to attend.

Industrial & Commercial Development Committee

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipalities Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 6:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Zoning Hearing Board

The Dover Township Zoning Hearing Board is a five member Board. This body is a Quasi Judicial Body whose authority is granted by the Municipalities Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. There is one alternate member. The term is a five year staggered term. Local authority guidance for operational decisions is established by the Dover Township Zoning Ordinance and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month **AS NEEDED**. 
Come by the station on October 31st for trick or treat! Hot chocolate & cookies will be provided.

Dover Township Leaf Collection 2025




THE BACKGROUND EQUIPMENT WAS PURCHASED WITH DEP 902 RECYCLING GRANT FUNDING. THIS UNIT WILL NOT ONLY HELP WITH THE SAFETY OF OUR PUBLIC WORKS CREWS BUT IT WILL ALSO DECREASE THE NEEDED MANPOWER FOR LEAF COLLECTION MOVING FORWARD. PUBLIC WORKS CREWS WILL BEGIN COLLECTING LEAVES STARTING OCTOBER 27TH THROUGH THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 1ST, 2025. HAVE ALL LEAVES TO THE CURB BY DECEMBER 2ND. PROVIDE DIRECT ACCESS TO THE LEAVES BY PARKING VEHICLES AWAY FROM THE PILES. LEAVES SHOULD BE PLACED ALONG THE CURB OR EDGE OF THE ROADWAY. DO NOT PLACE LEAF PILES BEHIND OR AROUND OBSTACLES SUCH AS TREES, MAILBOXES, POLES, ETC. LEAVES THAT ARE INACCESSIBLE WILL NOT BE COLLECTED. DO NOT PUT BRANCHES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, BRUSH, OR ANY DEBRIS UNDER OR IN THE LEAF PILE. THIS WILL CAUSE MAJOR DAMAGE TO THE EQUIPMENT AND DELAY THE COLLECTION. THERE IS NO SET SCHEDULE FOR THE LEAF COLLECTION CREWS SO PLEASE BE PATIENT AND REFRAIN FROM CALLING INTO THE TOWNSHIP. WE WILL DO OUR BEST TO PICK YOUR LEAVES UP IN A TIMELY MANNER. STAY UP TO DATE AND GET ALERTS ABOUT LEAF COLLECTION WITH THE SAVVY CITIZEN APP!

Dover Township Wastewater Treatment Facility Permit

The Dover Township Wastewater Treatment Facility just received their new National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit, effective June 1, 2025. The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PaDEP) issues and regulates these permits to ensure each facilities' effluent discharge meets specific water quality standards and limitations on certain parameters. These parameters and the limitations are set by PaDEP based on modeling current (and possible future) environmental impacts to the receiving streams and the bodies of water downstream (i.e. Chesapeake Bay).

The new NPDES permit for the Wastewater Treatment Facility has a few new parameters and some frequency changes to our old parameters.

Old Permit Effluent Parameters

Daily – pH, Dissolved Oxygen (DO), and %UV

2/week - Nitrate + Nitrite Nitrogen and Total Kjeldahl Nitrogen (TKN)

3/week – Fecal Coliform

5/week - Carbonaceous Biochemical Oxygen Demand (cBOD), Total Suspended Solids (TSS), Total Phosphorus, and Ammonia Nitrogen

1/month – Total Nitrogen

Old and Current Permit Influent Parameters

5/week - Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) and Total Suspended Solids (TSS)

New Permit Effluent Parameters

Daily – pH, Dissolved Oxygen (DO), %UV, Fecal Coliform, Carbonaceous Biochemical Oxygen Demand (cBOD), Total Suspended Solids (TSS), Total Phosphorus, and Ammonia Nitrogen

1/week – Total Dissolved Solids (TDS), Total Copper, Total Zinc, Bromide, Chloride, Total Sulfate, Dissolved Iron, Free Cyanide

2/week - Nitrate + Nitrite Nitrogen and Total Kjeldahl Nitrogen (TKN)

1/month – Total Nitrogen and E. coli

Quarterly/Yearly – Whole Effluent Toxicity Test (WETT), PFOS, PFOA, PFBS, and HFPO-DA.

These additional parameters (Total Copper, Total Zinc, Free Cyanide, Dissolved Iron, and WETT) were added based on water quality standards. Escherichia coli (E. coli) was added to conform with PaDEP existing effluent limitation guidelines. Total Dissolved Solids (TDS) and its constituents (Bromide, Chloride and Total Sulfate) were added due to possible future concerns to some Pennsylvania watersheds. Finally, PFAS (Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances) chemicals PFOS, PFOA, PFBS, and HFPO-DA were added according to PaDEP and EPA guidance.

Project Lifesaver



Project Lifesaver provides law enforcement with a program designed to protect, and when necessary, quickly locate individuals with cognitive disorders who are prone to the life-threatening behavior of wandering. The necessity of this program was determined through the correlation between cognitive conditions and the act of wandering. The program has grown from a localized program to a program recognized internationally as a proven and effective method of "bringing loved one's home."

The method relies on proven radio technology and specially trained search and rescue teams. Citizens enrolled in Project Lifesaver wear a small transmitter on the wrist or ankle that emits an individualized frequency signal. If an enrolled client goes missing, the caregiver notifies their local Project Lifesaver agency, and a trained emergency team responds to the wanderer's area. The first responders will then use the client's individualized frequency to locate the position of the individual.

The Northern York County Regional Police Department has nine officers trained in the operation of the Project Lifesaver Program. Four of these officers are School Resource Officers.



Proper Cart Placement

Please be advised that all mobile carts should be placed behind the curb. There should be nothing placed in the roadway that would impede or delay the removal of snow or ice from the road. The garbage truck arm has the capability to reach past the curb in order to pick up your cans.

Here are some tips to ensure a smooth collection process:

- ◆ Set mobile cart out the evening before pickup day.
- ◆ Place mobile cart with the lid handle and wheels pointing toward your residence.
- ◆ Do not place cart in the roadway.
- ◆ Do not block walkways with carts.
- ◆ Place carts at least **THREE FEET APART** from each other and mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, or utility poles - so trucks can easily access the cart.



Bulk Item Guidelines - Call to Schedule Pickup



Dover Township residents may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week. Please contact Penn Waste to schedule your bulk item for collection. Please have your bulk item available for collection at the curb by 6:00 AM.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS – Appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, three (3) 4 ft. rolls of carpet (tied).

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS – Electronic devices, chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/ industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete).

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS – Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Bulk items will be collected by appointment only. Please call Penn Waste at 717-767-4456 to schedule collection. Appliances with Freon must be scheduled with Penn Waste. Items include but are not limited to air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.






