Monroe County, Pennsylvania Authorization of One Point Zero Zero Zero (1.000) Mills Fire Tax Distribution Resolution # 18-2023

A resolution by the Coolbaugh Township Board of Supervisors establishing the disbursement of the funds from the One Point Zero Zero (1.000) Mills Fire Tax Revenue for the Fiscal year 2024.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Coolbaugh Township, Monroe County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as follows:

THAT the One Point Zero Zero (1.000) Mills Fire Tax Revenue for the fiscal year 2024 be distributed to the five (5) Volunteer Fire Companies that provide coverage to Coolbaugh Township as follows:

- 1. The first \$120,000.00 to be placed in one (1) interest bearing account to be managed by Coolbaugh Township and considered for distribution, in amounts to be determined by the Township, to the Gouldsboro Volunteer Fire Company, Pocono Summit Volunteer Fire Company, Thornhurst Volunteer Fire Company, and Tobyhanna Township Volunteer Fire Company upon written request for distributions. The decision as to how much of the Fire Tax Revenue to distribute to each of the four (4) above-referenced volunteer fire companies shall be within the discretion of the Board of Supervisors and shall not exceed \$120,000.00 per calendar year unless otherwise approved by the Coolbaugh Township Board of Supervisors. The above-referenced volunteer fire companies shall submit their written request to the Township on or before a date certain, to be set by the Township.
- 2. The remaining balance of dedicated Fire Tax Revenue received from the One Point Zero Zero (1.000) Mills Fire Tax shall be deposited into a separate second (2nd) interest bearing account to be managed by Coolbaugh Township to be distributed to the Coolbaugh Township Volunteer Fire Company.
- 3. The first account referenced in subsection 1 above (Gouldsboro, Pocono Summit, Thornhurst and Tobyhanna Township Fire Companies) shall be disbursed only for purposes set forth in the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 68205(a)(4), and which purposes are in the nature of capital expenditures only (not annual or current operations) and upon written request by the respective volunteer fire company. Such requests shall be subject to the formal approval of the Coolbaugh Township Board of Supervisors, which shall be within the Board's discretion and subject to certain guidelines set and/or otherwise considered pertinent by the Board of Supervisors in a manner consistent with the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code.
- 4. The second account referenced in subsection 2 above (Coolbaugh Township Volunteer Fire Company) shall be disbursed only for purposes set forth in the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. § 68205(a)(4), and which purposes are in the nature of capital expenditures, including but not limited to fire apparatus and a suitable place to house fire apparatus, as well as annual or current operational purposes (appropriations) and upon written request by the fire company. Such request shall be subject to the formal approval of the Coolbaugh Township Board of Supervisors.

Release of 50,000 for the annual Tanker payment



Dear Board Members:

The attached letter from RKR Hess, dated December 1, 2023, requests the release/reduction of the financial security for all the Phase I improvements and most of the Phase I Second Amendment improvements at the Messer Cylinder Filling Plant. This request is supported by the certified spreadsheet included with the letter, and was field verified on October 11, 2023.

This request is for the Township to reduce the financial security, while still retaining of 110% of the estimated cost of the remaining Phase I Second Amendment improvements, plus the Phase II improvements, and the Phase II Alternate ESC improvements (\$488,876.30 total), plus the required 15% stormwater maintenance security for Phase I and the Phase I Second Amendment (\$62,872.50 total) for 18 months, leaving a total retained balance of \$551,748.80, as indicated in the letter and on the last page of the spreadsheet.

Since it has been verified that the amounts indicated accurately reflect the total of the remaining work plus the required stormwater maintenance security, it would be appropriate to reduce the financial security as requested, to a total balance of **\$551,748.80**.

Enclosed is a request for the release of escrow for required improvements for the Messer project. RKR Hess has reviewed the completed improvements and confirmed the improvements have been installed in accordance with the requirements of the Land Development Plans. All of the required improvements for Phase I have been completed and most improvements for Phase I second amendment have been completed. A spreadsheet is attached outlining the completed improvements and the remaining escrow balance. A 15% balance of the stormwater management improvements will remain for 18 months. The remaining balance is summarized below.



RESOLUTION NO. 19-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF COOLBAUGH AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE 1996 AGREEMENT ON POCONO MOUNTAIN REGIONAL POLICE, AS AMENDED, BETWEEN TOBYHANNA TOWNSHIP, TUNKHANNOCK TOWNSHIP, COOLBAUGH TOWNSHIP, MOUNT POCONO BOROUGH AND BARRETT TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, The Township of Coolbaugh previously entered into the Agreement on Pocono Mountain Regional Police dated November 19, 1996, as amended, and now intends to authorize the execution of an Amendment to the 1996 Agreement, as amended.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Chapter 23, Subchapter A, Intergovernmental Cooperation, of the General Local Government Code, 53 Pa. C.S. §2301, et seq., a municipality may enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement upon the passage of a resolution by its governing body.
