

2026 Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program

The annual Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) is available to eligible seniors across Allegheny County. Eligible seniors may receive one set of vouchers to be spent at participating farmers markets. Please check income guidelines below to see if you qualify.

Farmers' Market Vouchers will be distributed via mail for 2026

You must complete a 2026 application. Once we receive, we will process the application and mail your vouchers back to you via the U.S. Postal Service. To process your application, it must be completed in **full** including:

- 🍓 Full Name
- 🍓 Date of Birth
- 🍓 Signature (attesting to income)
- 🍓 Entire address, including street, apt. number, city, state and zip code

One set of vouchers is worth \$25.00 (issued as five vouchers worth \$5.00 each). The vouchers may be used through November 30th at participating farmer's markets to purchase produce that is **grown in Pennsylvania**. Examples of Pennsylvania produce are apples, beans, berries, carrots, grapes, melons, spinach and tomatoes. Seniors must spend the entire \$5.00 voucher; change will not be given. Lost or stolen vouchers will not be replaced.

Eligibility:

- 🍏 Allegheny County resident
- 🍏 60 years of age or older (by December 31, 2026)
- 🍏 Meet the income guidelines (self-reported):
 - One person household: At or below \$ 29,526
 - Two-person household: At or below \$ 40,034
- 🍏 Older adults living in a residential facility that provides meals are not eligible to receive vouchers
