MAIN STREET PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR MILLING AND PAVING OPERATIONS

The Town of Louisa advises residents, businesses, and visitors that temporary parking restrictions will be in place on Main Street due to upcoming milling and paving operations.

Milling operations are scheduled to begin at approximately 8:00 p.m. on September 9, 2026, and continue through approximately 8:00 a.m. on September 10, 2026. The initial milling work will affect Main Street from 310 W. Main Street to Fredericksburg Avenue.

NO PARKING will be permitted within the designated work area during the scheduled overnight operations. Motorists and visitors are asked to remove all vehicles from the affected areas prior to the start of work to allow the contractor to safely and efficiently complete the milling operations.

This initial parking restriction will be a one-night event associated with the milling phase of the project. A second round of parking restrictions will be required during the paving phase of the project. The Town will provide additional notification regarding the paving schedule and associated parking restrictions once the contractor's schedule has been confirmed.

Please be advised that the contractor's schedule may be adjusted due to weather, unforeseen site conditions, or other operational considerations. This press release will be updated as the contractor's schedule is updated.

The Town appreciates the cooperation and patience of residents, businesses, and visitors while these necessary roadway improvements are completed.

For everyone's safety, please use caution when traveling through the work area and follow all posted traffic control and parking restrictions.
