



Now that our Osprey Chicks have fledged, your Cedar Key Water and Sewer District will conduct a Chemical Washout of our 250,000-gallon water tower located at the corner of G Street and Whiddon Avenue. This washout will thoroughly clean the inside of the water tank and will require the water tower to be empty for up to 48 hours beginning Tuesday, August 5th.

During this process, residents may experience low water pressure and may want to take water supply measures ahead of the washout. Once the washout is complete, the need to refill the water tower will be of the utmost importance. We ask all Cedar Keyans to help the water tower refill process by lessening water usage over the days following August 5th. Our Fire Department has been alerted and Chief Robinson and his Department have made the necessary adjustments to provide fire protection.
