SUBJECT: MPT Guidance on 2026-2027 DC Local Share Gaming Grants

Information regarding the Dauphin County Annual Local Share Gaming Grant Program has recently been released by the County. Grant applications are due to the County by **November 2, 2026**. This notice is intended to help community partners stay on schedule with their submissions while also giving the Township Board of Supervisors an opportunity to consider requests for support.

Applicants are encouraged to consult directly with Dauphin County regarding any pre-application meetings, eligibility requirements, or other submission guidelines associated with the program.

Middle Paxton Township will hold a single presentation meeting during a regularly scheduled Business Meeting of the Board of Supervisors on **Thursday, September 10**, at 7:00 PM. During this meeting, the Board will hear presentations from all organizations seeking Township support for proposed projects.

Organizations located within Middle Paxton Township wishing to present to the Board must submit project materials, including a project scope and grant application, to the Township Manager no later than **Thursday, September 3, 2026, at 4:00 PM**. Applicants are strongly encouraged to attend the September 10, 2026, regular business meeting to present their projects and answer any questions from the Board.

Following the workshop meeting, the Board of Supervisors will review and rank all projects requesting Township support and co-applicant participation. Final letters of support and sponsorship will be issued shortly after the Board's October 5, 2026, business meeting, during which the Board will formally vote on the project ranking structure.
