Township Building Access During Construction:

Dover Township will be completing a building addition and renovation project which is anticipated to begin March of 2025 and continue for approximately 12 months. During that time the public will be affected in several ways:

1.) A map is being provided to aid the public, vendors and other agencies in determining how to access the facility during construction.
2.) Since construction is located to the front of the building, construction activity will limit public access. The Public Entrance to the facility will therefore be from Brooklyn Road only. Those needing to turn left out of our facility will need to do so from the normal entrance depicted by a Red X on the map which is EXIT ONLY.

3.) Front Office Operations including Utility Billing and Reception will be located in an office trailer to the rear of the building off of Brooklyn Road near the Eagle View Parking Lot depicted by a Brown Rectangle. A Drop Box for payments will be located at the Blue Dot on the map.

4.) During construction, all public meetings will be relocated to the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road. We will begin holding meetings at this location with the March 24th Board of Supervisors Meeting.

We apologize for the inconvenience that will likely come during this construction; however these improvements are necessary to provide for future staffing, an enlarged public meeting room capacity, and security to the building. Public Meetings

Board of Supervisors

The Board of Supervisors will hold their regular meetings in the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the second (2nd) and fourth (4th) Mondays of the month. The Dover Township Board of Supervisors invites the public to attend.

Industrial & Commercial Development Committee

The Dover Township Industrial and Commercial Development Committee promotes industrial and commercial activities that will expand the greater Dover area tax base. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 4:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Planning Commission

The Dover Township Planning Commission is a five member Commission with one alternate member. The term of office is a five year staggered term. This Commission is an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The Authority is granted by the Municipalities Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The local ordinance of control is the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance of Dover Township and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the first (1st) Wednesday of the month.

Sewer Authority

The Dover Township Sewer Authority is the owner and financier of the Wastewater Treatment Facility, a regional facility, for Dover Township. The body is a five member, staggered term, Authority authorized by the Authorities Act of 1945 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. It is a Non-Operating Authority due to a "Lease Back Agreement" of operation to the Township. Meetings are held at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 851 Graffius Road, York, Pennsylvania, at 6:00 PM on the fourth (4th) Wednesday of the month.

Zoning Hearing Board

The Dover Township Zoning Hearing Board is a five member Board. This body is a Quasi Judicial Body whose authority is granted by the Municipalities Planning Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. There is one alternate member. The term is a five year staggered term. Local authority guidance for operational decisions is established by the Dover Township Zoning Ordinance and the Dover Township Comprehensive Plan. Meetings are held at the Community Building Banquet Room located at 3700 Davidsburg Road, Dover, Pennsylvania, at 7:00 PM on the third (3rd) Wednesday of the month **AS NEEDED**. Please check www.dovertownship.org for details and updates on scheduled meetings.

Planned work at a few Dover Township facilities in 2025

Brookside Park- Three roofs will be replaced in the park due to being at the end of their life. They will now also match the red roofs within the park. The Carousel Building will have a 12' commercial fan. This building was built without any heat or air conditioning, so the fan will help keep it comfortable in the summer for renters and events. The cost of the fans and roof replacements is around \$23,000.00.

Lehr Park/Community Building- The parking lot will be getting repaved and expanded this year. The current pavement is starting to be in poor condition, and we are adding more spaces for the various township events, sports tournaments, etc. The Community Building will have three (3) of the five (5) aging rooftop units (HVAC) replaced. They will be replaced with more efficient units. The cost of the parking lot and new rooftop units is around \$375,000.00.

Community Park- Last year we had new support posts put on the pavilion at Community Park. This year the pavilion will have a new roof and siding to bring it back to like new condition. The bathrooms will be receiving a matching roof as well. In addition, we will have paved walking paths to make access to the amenities easier, and security cameras to keep our parks safer. Dover Township is hopeful the new camera system will result in less vandalism. The cost of these projects is around \$45,000.00.

DOVER TOWNSHIP REFUSE AND RECYCLING

Dover Township, as required by the Second-Class Township Code, authorized the advertisement to receive competitive bids for the collection of refuse and recycling from July 2025 through June 2030. The Township received four bids and the bid tabulation can be found at <https://www.dovertownship.org/refuse-recycling-bid-tab-results/>. On July 1, 2025, Dover Township will begin a new contract with the lowest bidder, Penn Waste for refuse and recycling collection. There should be little disruption in your service as Penn Waste is the Township's current waste hauler. Residents will have several options for the removal of trash and recyclables. The regular service will start at \$335.40 for a year for July 2025 to June 2026. Regular weekly service includes regular volume trash pick-up utilizing a ninety-six (96) gallon toter, weekly recycling with a sixty-four (64) gallon toter, large item pick-up including Christmas tree removal in January, and unlimited brush one Saturday each calendar month. The Low Volume Service will start at \$261.24 for July 2025 to June 2026. This includes low volume trash utilizing a thirty-two to thirty-five (32-35) gallon toter, weekly recycling with a sixty-four (64) gallon toter, large item pick-up including Christmas tree removal in January, and unlimited brush pick-up one Saturday each calendar month. The Recycle Only service will start at \$195.60 per year for July 2025 to June 2026. This includes weekly recycling pick up utilizing a sixty-four (64) gallon toter, large item pick-up including Christmas tree pick-up in January, and unlimited brush pick up one Saturday each calendar month. Increases will occur yearly in July during the length of contract as well as in January if there is an increase in the tipping fee charged for the processing of municipal waste by the York County Recovery Center.

The Township will continue to conduct leaf collection in the fall.

Bulk item pick up includes refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, hot water heaters, washing machines, dryers, freezers, chairs, rolled carpet, desks, bureaus, tables, mattresses, box springs, bed frames, sofas, bundled wood, lawn mowers, bath tubs, toilets, sinks, windows, window screens, doors, similar household items and two (2) tires without rims that do not exceed an outside diameter of thirty-two (32) inches or a maximum tread width of twelve (12) inches.

Refuse and Recycling will be picked up on the same day. A trash collection route map along with answers to other refuse and recycling questions can be found at www.dovertownship.org.

Collection of refuse and recycling will occur weekly between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

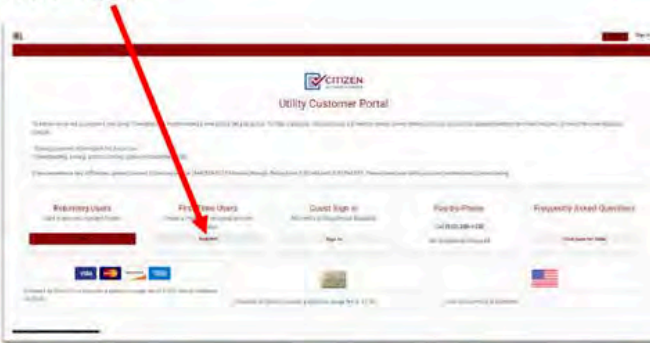

faucet run for 3 to 5 minutes.

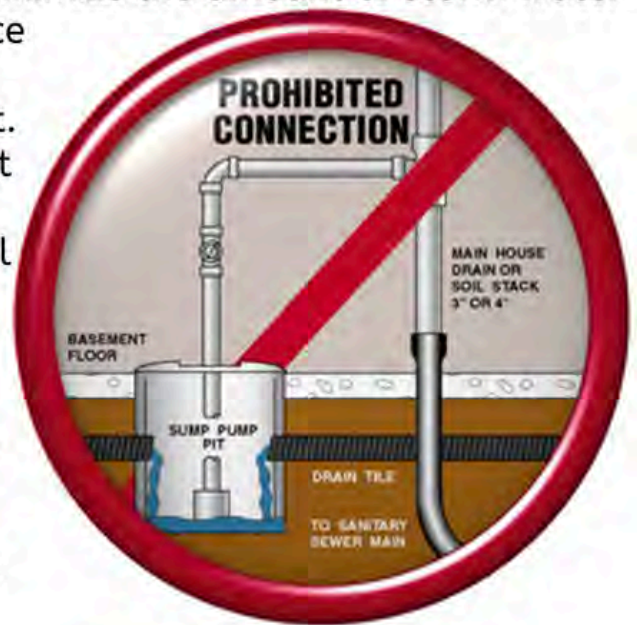

Inflow & Infiltration Inspections

The Dover Township Utilities Department has started Inflow & Infiltration Inspections within the sewer collection system. These inspections are done in your home to ensure that there is no storm water entering the sanitary sewer system by means of sump pumps, rain spouts or floor drains connected to the sanitary sewer system. It is important to minimize the amount of storm water entering the sanitary sewer system to reduce the amount of wastewater that the Wastewater Treatment Plant needs to treat. If the I&I is not reduced, it increases the cost of treating the wastewater and rates will need to be increased to cover the additional cost.

Other ways you can help your community reduce I&I is if you see a manhole missing a cover or a sewer clean out missing a cap, please call Dover Township at 717-292-3634 so our utilities department can correct the problem. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.



Northern York County Regional Police Project Lifesaver



Project Lifesaver provides law enforcement with a program designed to protect, and when necessary, quickly locate individuals with cognitive disorders who are prone to the life threatening behavior of wandering. The necessity of this program was determined through the correlation between cognitive conditions and the act of wandering. The program has grown from a localized program to a program recognized internationally as a proven and effective method of "bringing loved ones home."

The method relies on proven radio technology and specially trained search and rescue teams. Citizens enrolled in Project Lifesaver wear a small transmitter on the wrist or ankle that emits an individualized frequency signal. If an enrolled client goes missing, the caregiver notifies their local Project Lifesaver agency, and a trained emergency team responds to the wanderer's area. The first responders will then use the client's individualized frequency to locate the position of the individual.

The Northern York County Regional Police Department has nine officers trained in the operation of the Project Lifesaver Program. Four of these officers are School Resource Officers.

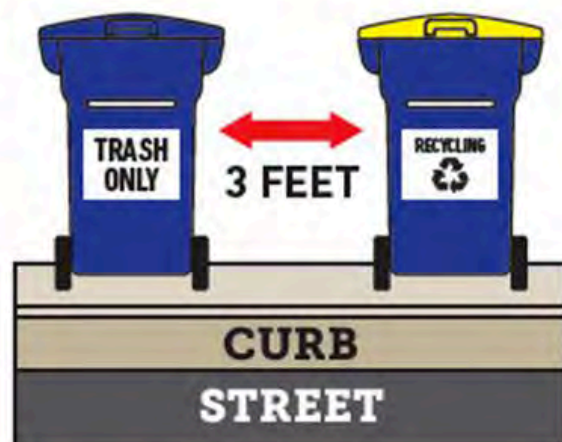

Proper Cart Placement

Please be advised that all mobile carts should be placed behind the curb. There should be nothing placed in the roadway that would impede or delay the removal of snow or ice from the road. The garbage truck arm has the capability to reach past the curb in order to pick up your cans.

Here are some tips to ensure a smooth collection process:

- ◆ Set mobile cart out the evening before pickup day.
- ◆ Place mobile cart with the lid handle and wheels pointing toward your residence.
- ◆ Do not place cart in the roadway.
- ◆ Do not block walkways with carts.
- ◆ Place carts at least **THREE FEET APART** from each other and mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, or utility poles - so trucks can easily access the cart.



Bulk Item Guidelines - Call to Schedule Pickup



Dover Township residents may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week. Please contact Penn Waste to schedule your bulk item for collection. Please have your bulk item available for collection at the curb by 6:00 AM.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS – Appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, three (3) 4 ft. rolls of carpet (tied).

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS – Electronic devices, chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/ industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete).

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS – Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Bulk items will be collected by appointment only. Please call Penn Waste at 717-767-4456 to schedule collection. Appliances with Freon must be scheduled with Penn Waste. Items include but are not limited to air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.

Wastewater Laboratory

The Dover Township Wastewater Treatment Facilities' Laboratory is Pennsylvania State Accredited for wastewater samples only. The accreditation status was obtained in 2006. Therefore, the Laboratory must conform to Chapter 252 regulations. Chapter 252 (Environmental Laboratory Accreditation) was established in 2006 "to protect the public health, safety, welfare and the environment by ensuring the accuracy, precision, and reliability of data generated by environmental laboratories" (Section 252.2). This was also the same year that the Chesapeake Bay Agreement was added to our NDPES (National Discharge Pollutant Elimination System) permit. This required our treatment facility to undergo BNR (Biological Nutrient Removal). The Wastewater Treatment Facility is currently in review for a new NDPES Permit.

The Laboratory has two equally important responsibilities. First, the Laboratory must prove to State and Federal agencies that the water discharged into the Little Conewago Creek and the biosolids that become agricultural soil amendments meet or exceed all regulatory levels (performed by outside laboratories). The testing includes quality control and internal monitoring. We must be able to prove that the data is honest and trustworthy. The second responsibility of the Laboratory is to monitor and troubleshoot the treatment process. This information is given to the Operators to effectively and efficiently adjust the treatment the process.

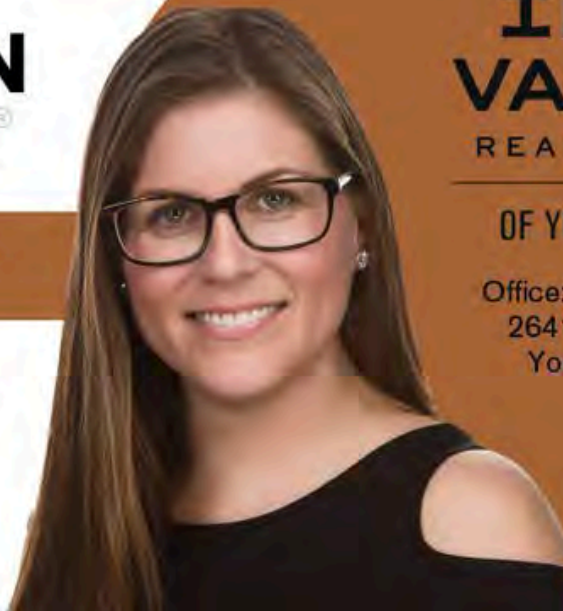


