"We are aware of a harmful algal bloom on the Withlacoochee River. FDEP recently sampled at multiple locations on the river, and confirmed the presence of *Microcystis aeruginosa*, a cyanobacteria. Additional sampling is planned, and results can be viewed on the [Algal Bloom Sampling Status](#) webpage. If you see abnormal fish behavior, fish disease, or fish kills, submit a report to FWC's Fish Kill Hotline either through the web form MyFWC.com/ReportFishKill or by calling 800-636-0511. These reports are vital for understanding the causes, patterns, and occurrences of fish kills and fish disease in Florida waters. They also enable FWC to collaborate with partners and guide effective responses to these events."
