



My property was damaged during the hurricane. What should I do?

We are here to assist you through the assessment process. Assessment day is January 1st. The assessment for your 2024 taxes were based on the way your property stood January 1, 2024. The assessment for your 2025 taxes will be based on the way your property stands January 1, 2025.

2025 Property Assessment

- Report Storm Damage at www.qpublic.net/FL/Levy, please provide a valid phone number and email address.
- Confirm your mailing address is correct with our office

Applying for Tax Relief

- The property owner must pay the taxes for the year in which the catastrophic event occurred.
- Residential improvement must be uninhabitable for at least 30 days due to the catastrophic event.
- The property owner must file an application for refund with the property appraiser DR-465 no later than March 1 of the year immediately following the catastrophic event.
- Application should have documentation, including, but not limited to the following: utility bills, insurance information, contractors' statements, building permit applications, or building inspection certificates of occupancy.

If Eligible and Approved

- The Tax Collector will send a refund, it generally takes 4-6 weeks.
