Know Your Risk and Be Informed

Know Your Terms

Assemble Emergency Supplies

Prepare an <u>emergency kit</u> by picking up a few extra items each time you go shopping—before you know it, you will have an emergency kit ready for the next storm.



Get an Insurance Check-Up

Where it can rain, it can flood. Neither homeowners or renters insurance cover flooding. Get flood coverage under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).



<u>Help Your Neighbor</u>

Make sure your neighborhood is <u>prepared</u>. Check on your neighbors and friends.



Complete an Emergency and Communications Plan

Write it all down and keep it in a safe place. Practice your <u>Emergency and</u> Communications Plan annually.
